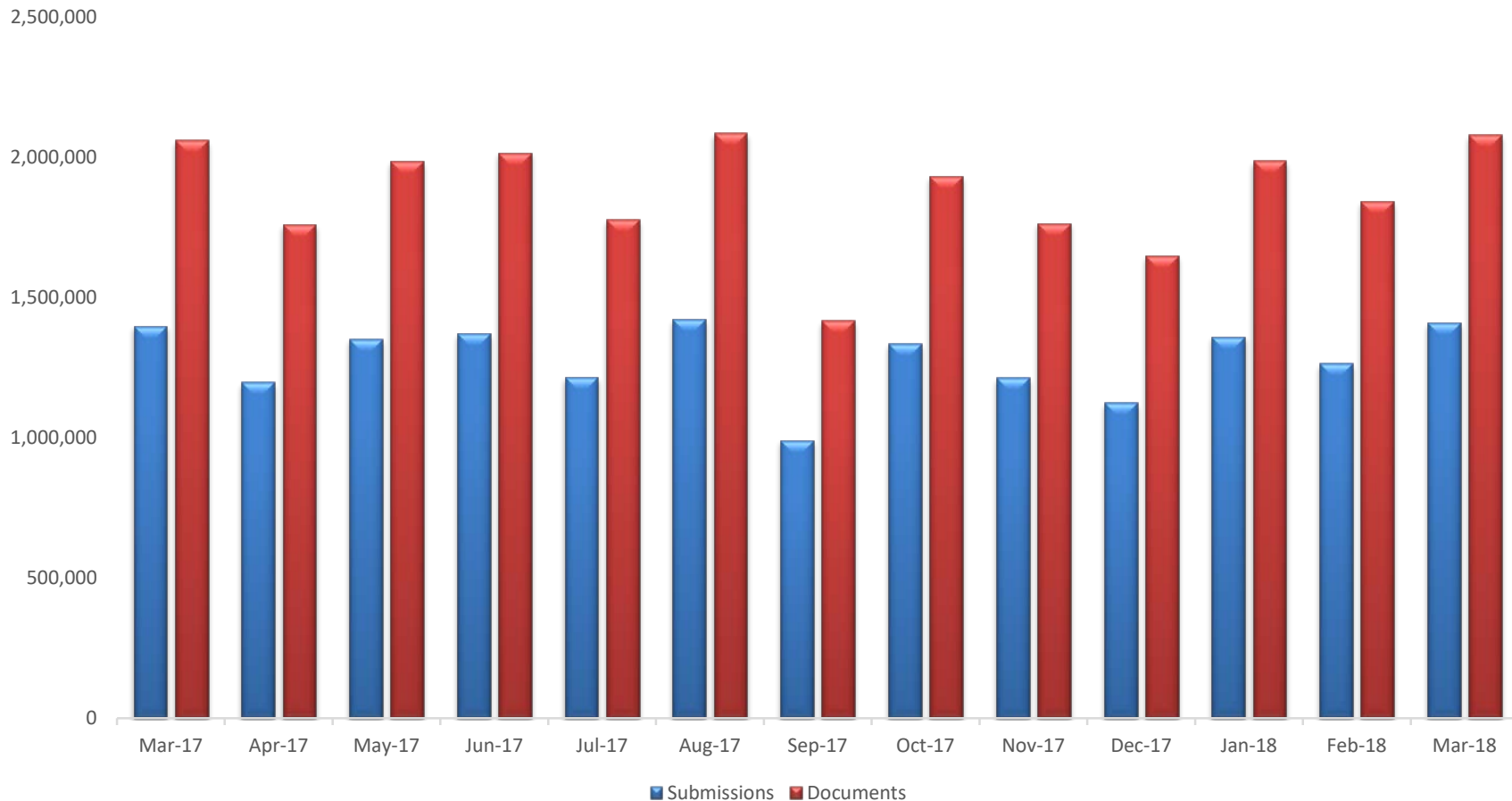
May had the highest volume day on May 31, 2017 at 74,102 submissions

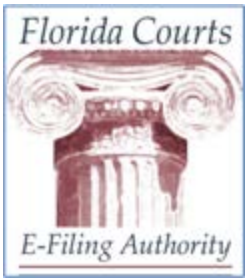
January, 2018 has the most submissions during the 3:00 P.M. hour at 8,531

January, 2018 had the most new cases filed during a given month at 74,629

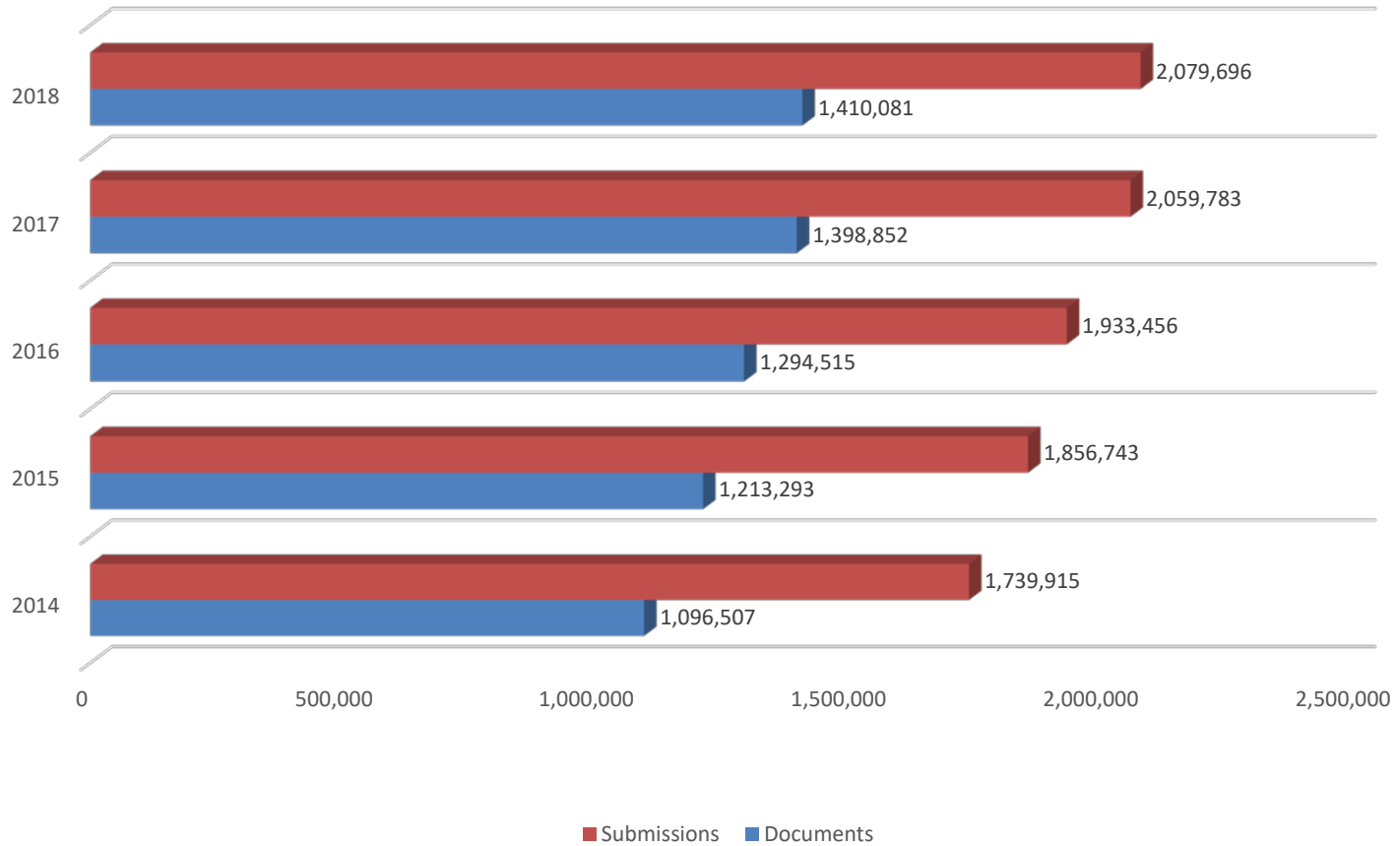


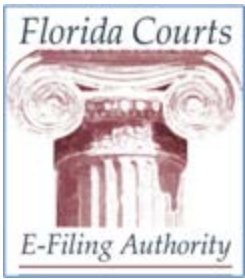
Year at a Glance



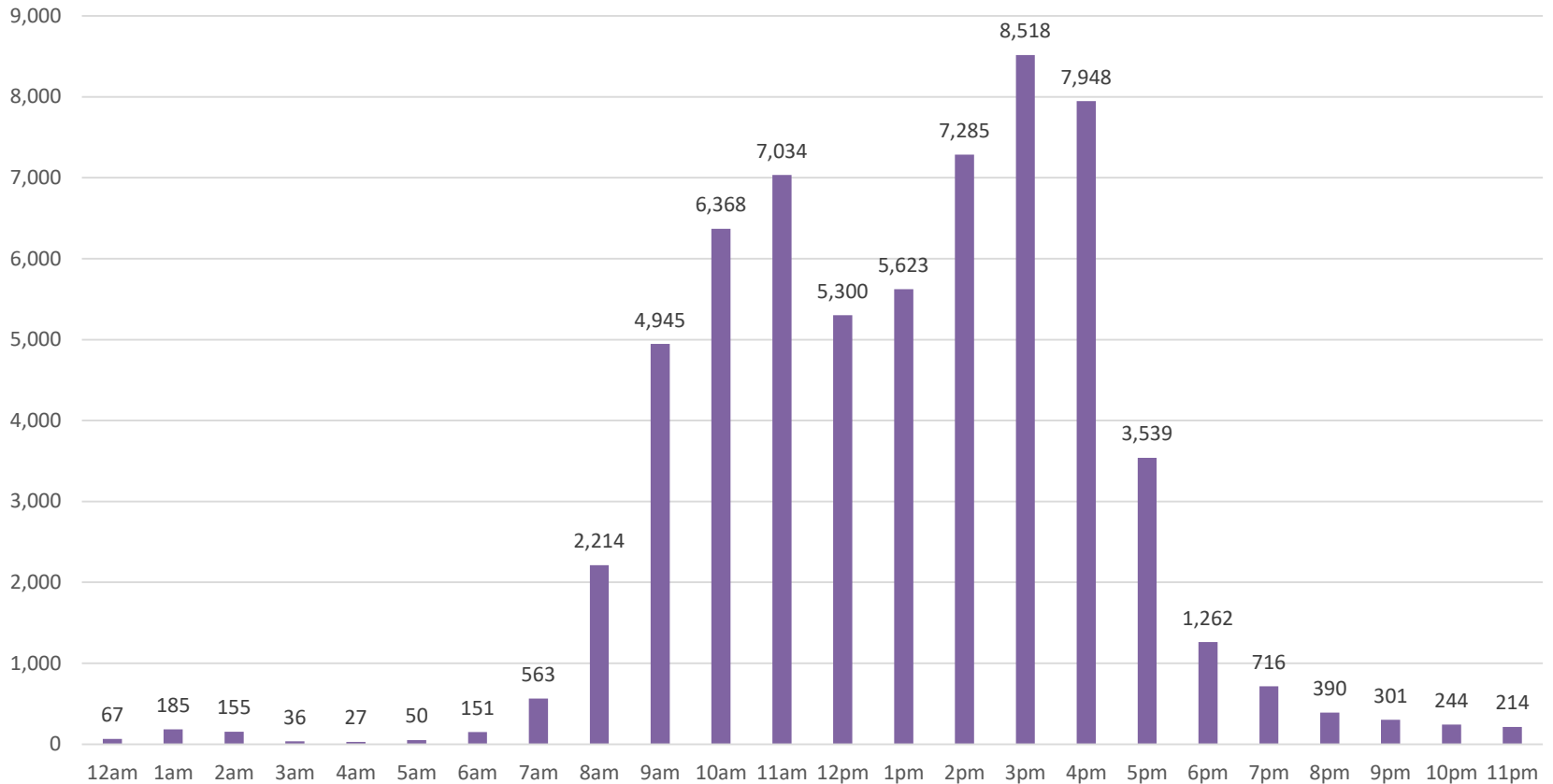


March E-Filing Last Five Years



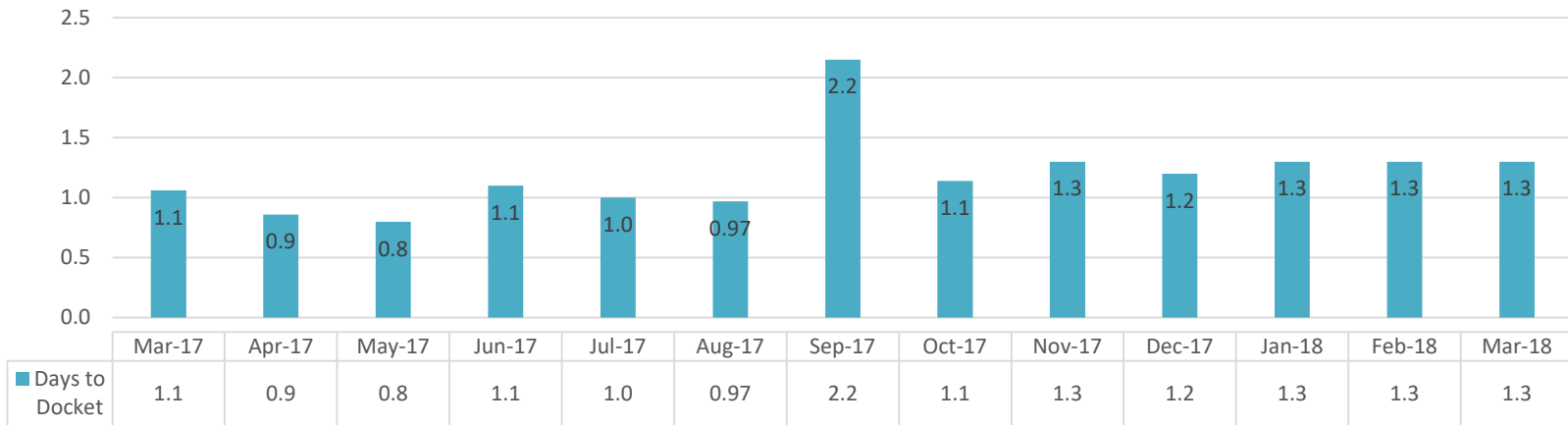


Average # Filings Per Hour in March





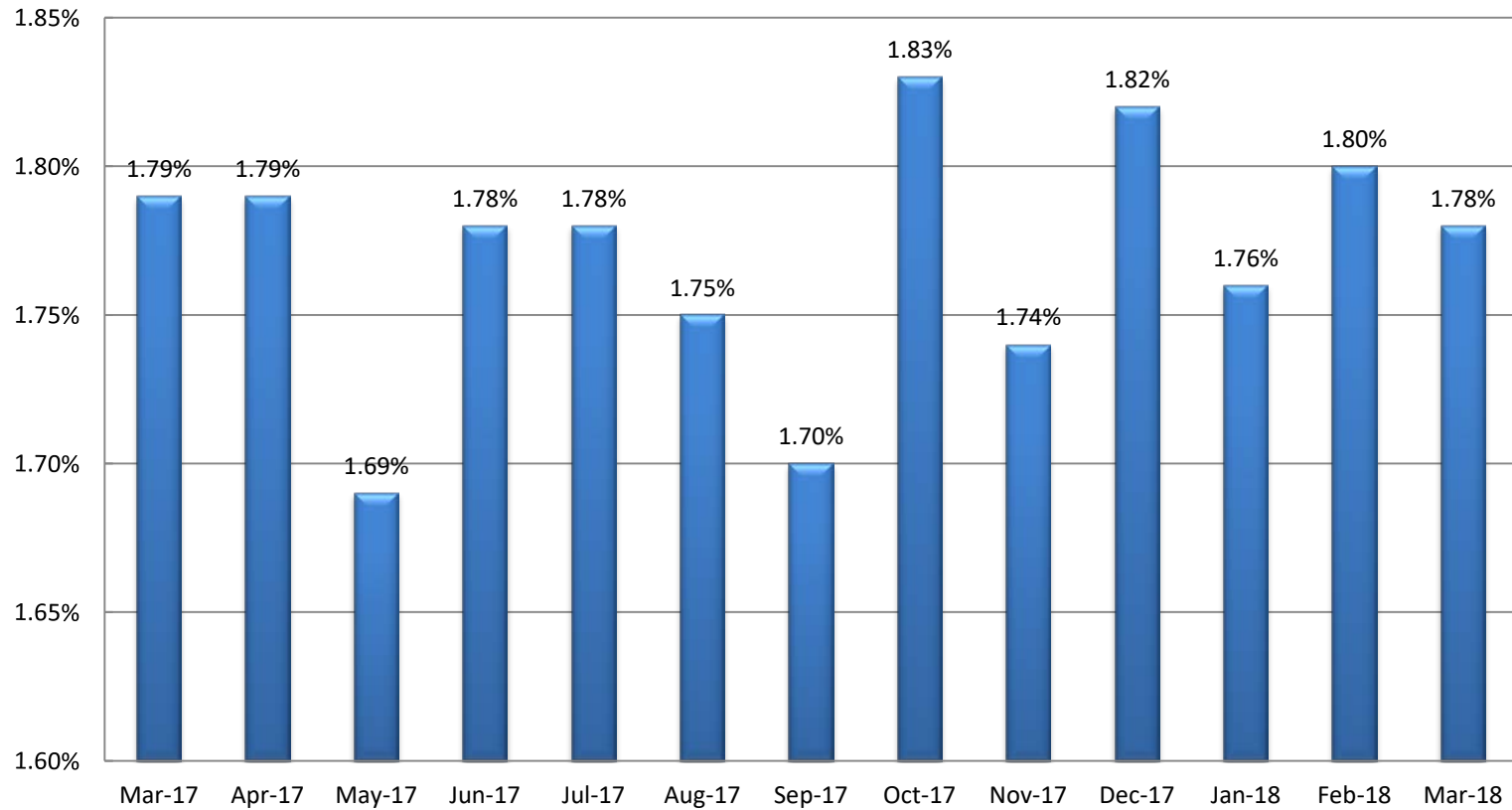
Average # Days to Docket

% Submissions Returned to Correction Queue



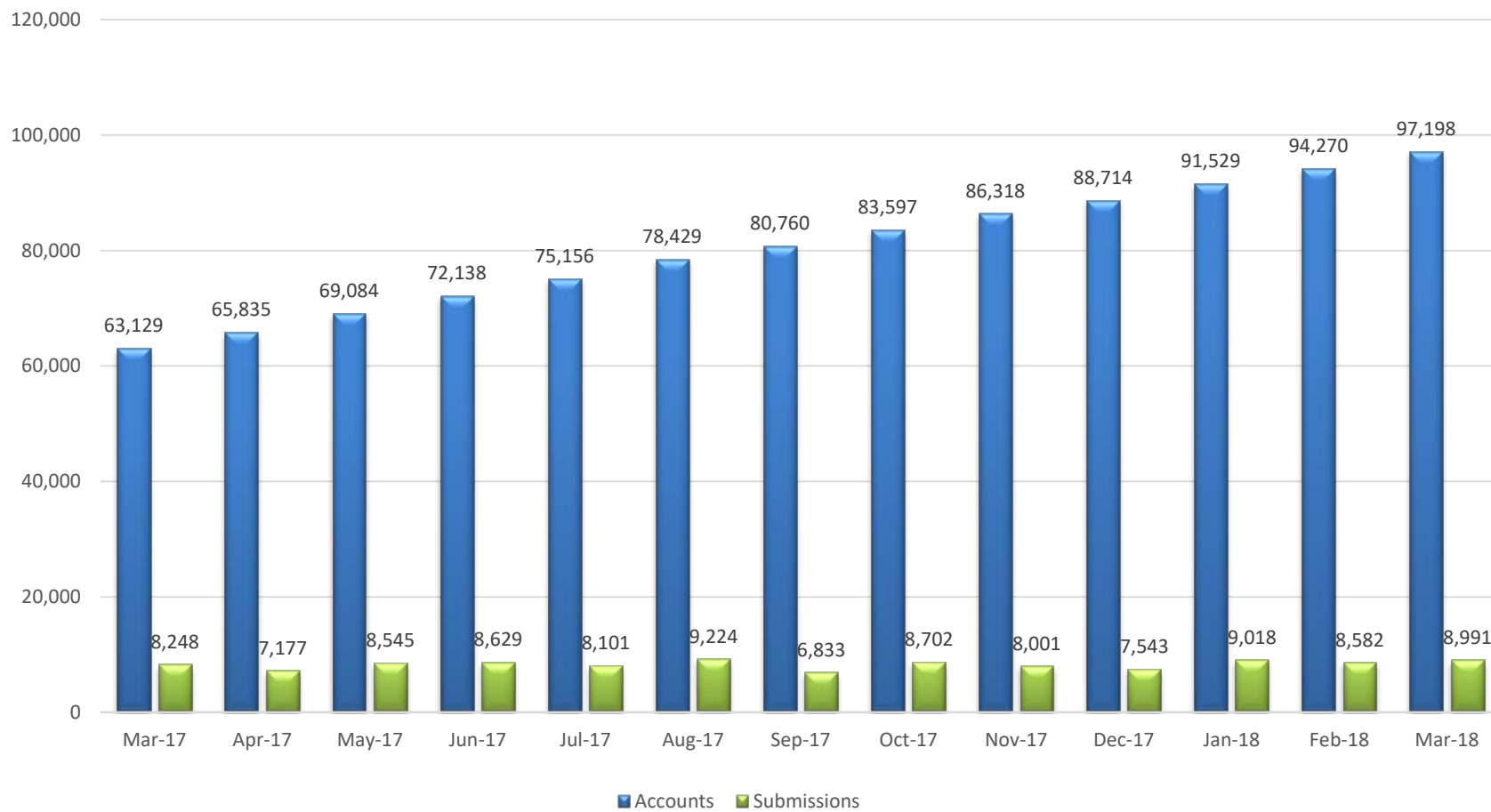

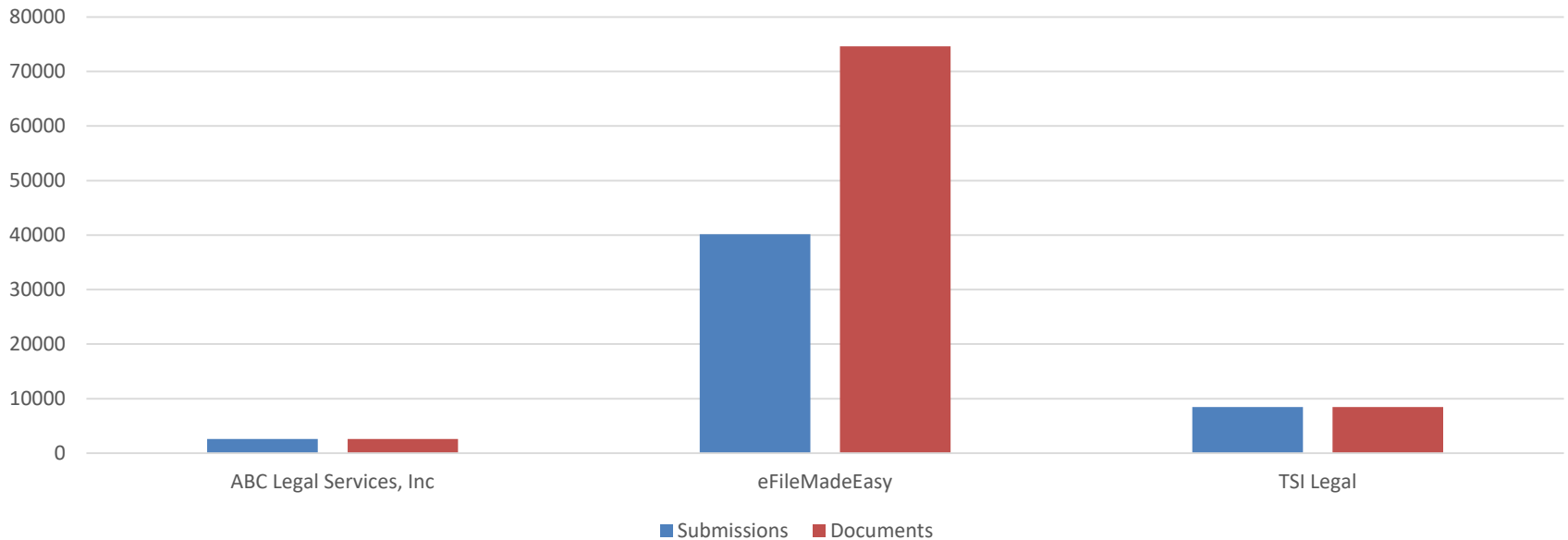

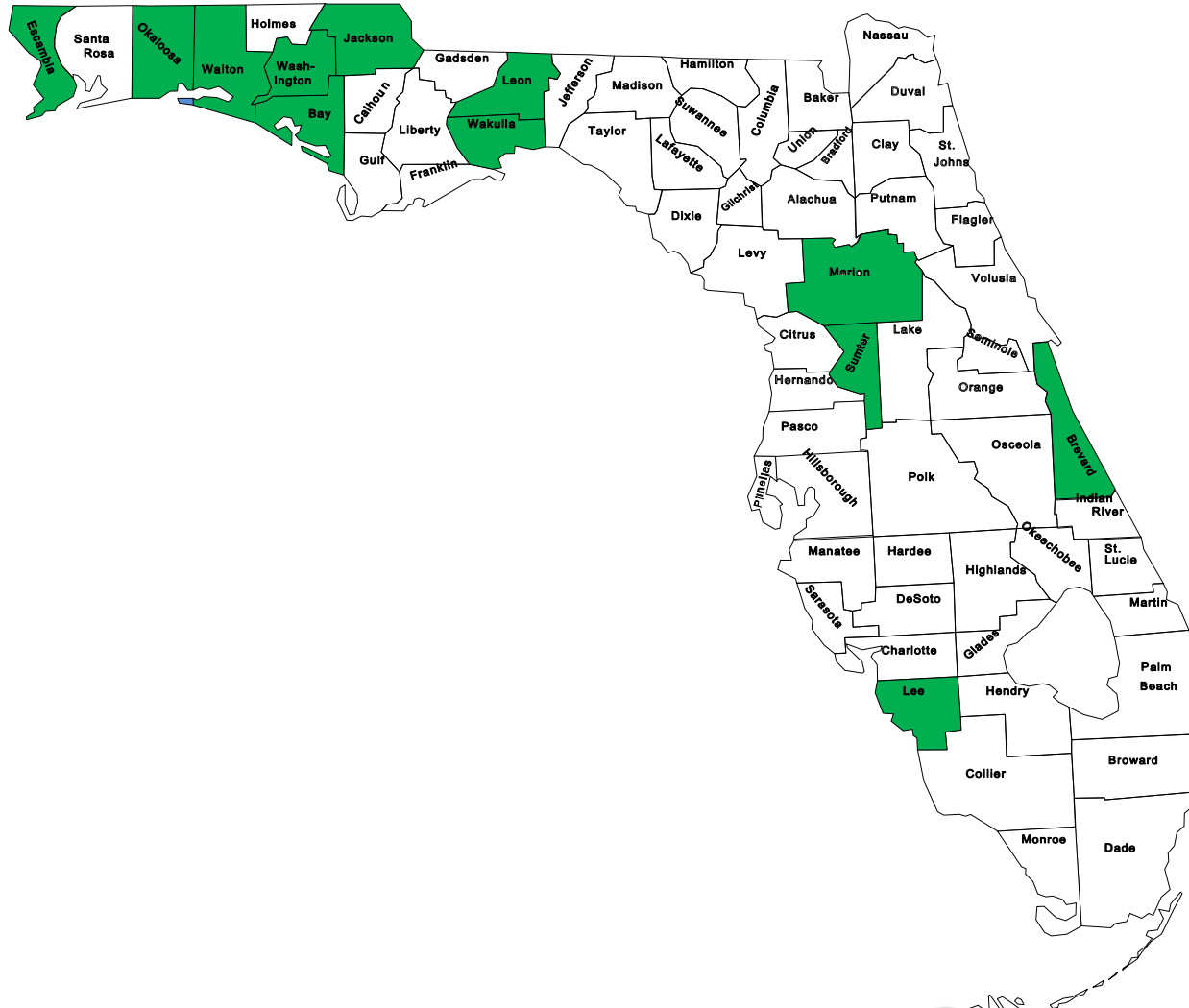
