WEBSITE POSTING POLICY

PURPOSE OF WEBSITE

The Florida Courts E-Filing Portal website www.myflcourtaaccess.com is intended to provide an access point for electronic filings of court records and electronic service of such records as well as information about the Florida Courts E-Filing Authority (the “Authority”), its board members, meeting materials, and events.

The website is provided as a service to the members of the public and is not intended to imply any endorsement of organizations or businesses listed or to promote any goods or services mentioned.

In an effort to maintain the website as a safe and secure location for disseminating information to the public, the following guidelines have been established.

WEBSITE POSTING REQUESTS

The Authority has full discretion in deciding what content is published on the website. Individuals or entities wishing to post information on the website must first obtain approval from the Authority. Requests shall include:

- Name and contact information of the individual or entity submitting a request.
- Description of the content they wish to post on the website and a copy of such document or link.
- How such information will further the objective of the Authority to maintain a statewide system for electronic filings of court records.

WEBSITE CONTENT GUIDELINES

Posted content must be in accordance with all applicable laws. Posted material must not:

- Defame or threaten others.
- Infringe upon copyrighted material.
- Use registered trademarks of others without the knowledge and consent of its owner.
- Advertise or promote products and services not authorized by the Authority.
- Provide links to external sites that are not related to the Authority’s primary functions.
- Photos of people shall not be used without written permission from the subject.
