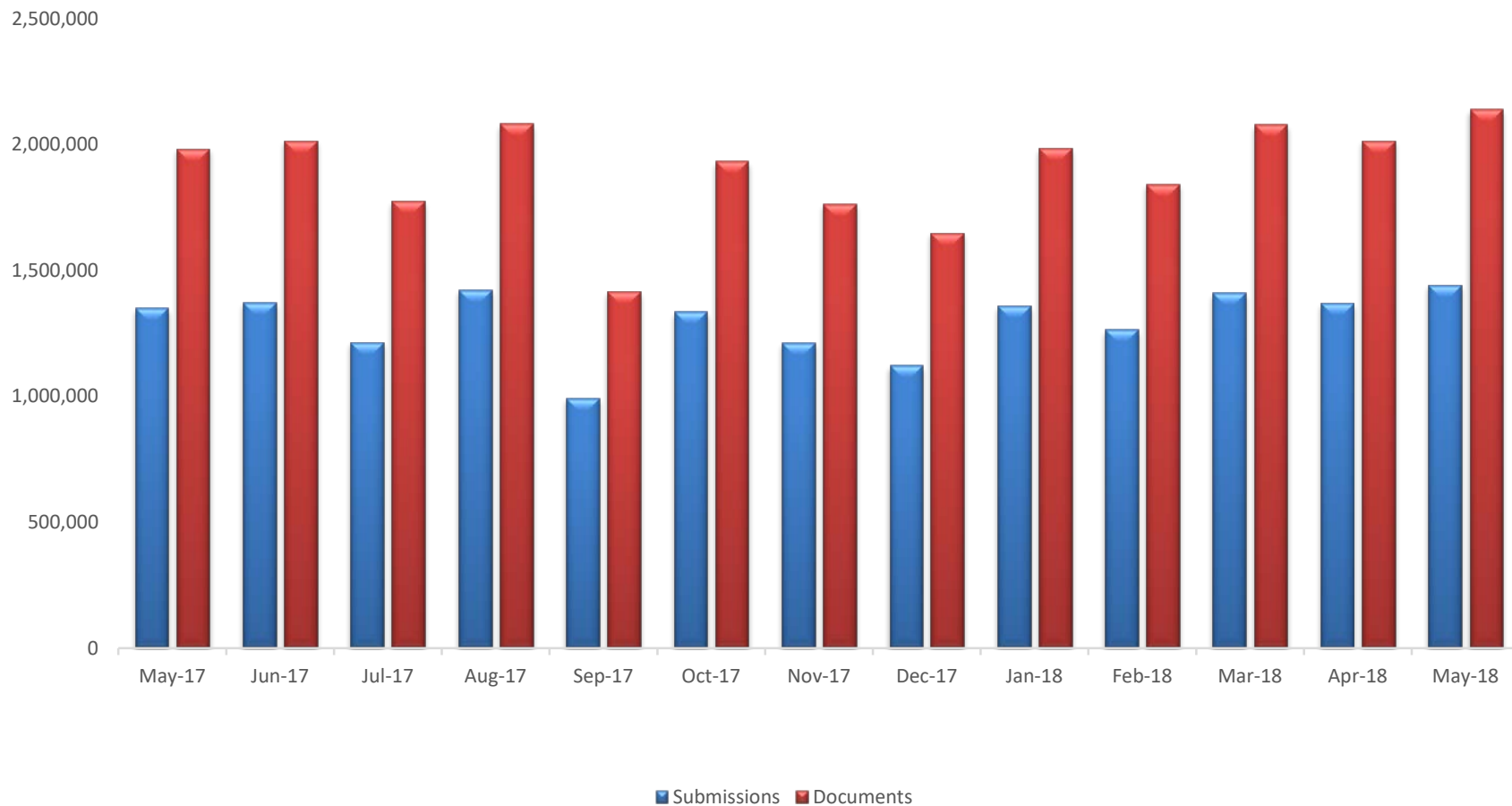

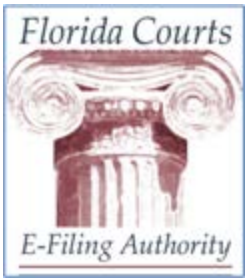

March 2018 had the most new cases filed during a given month at 78,994

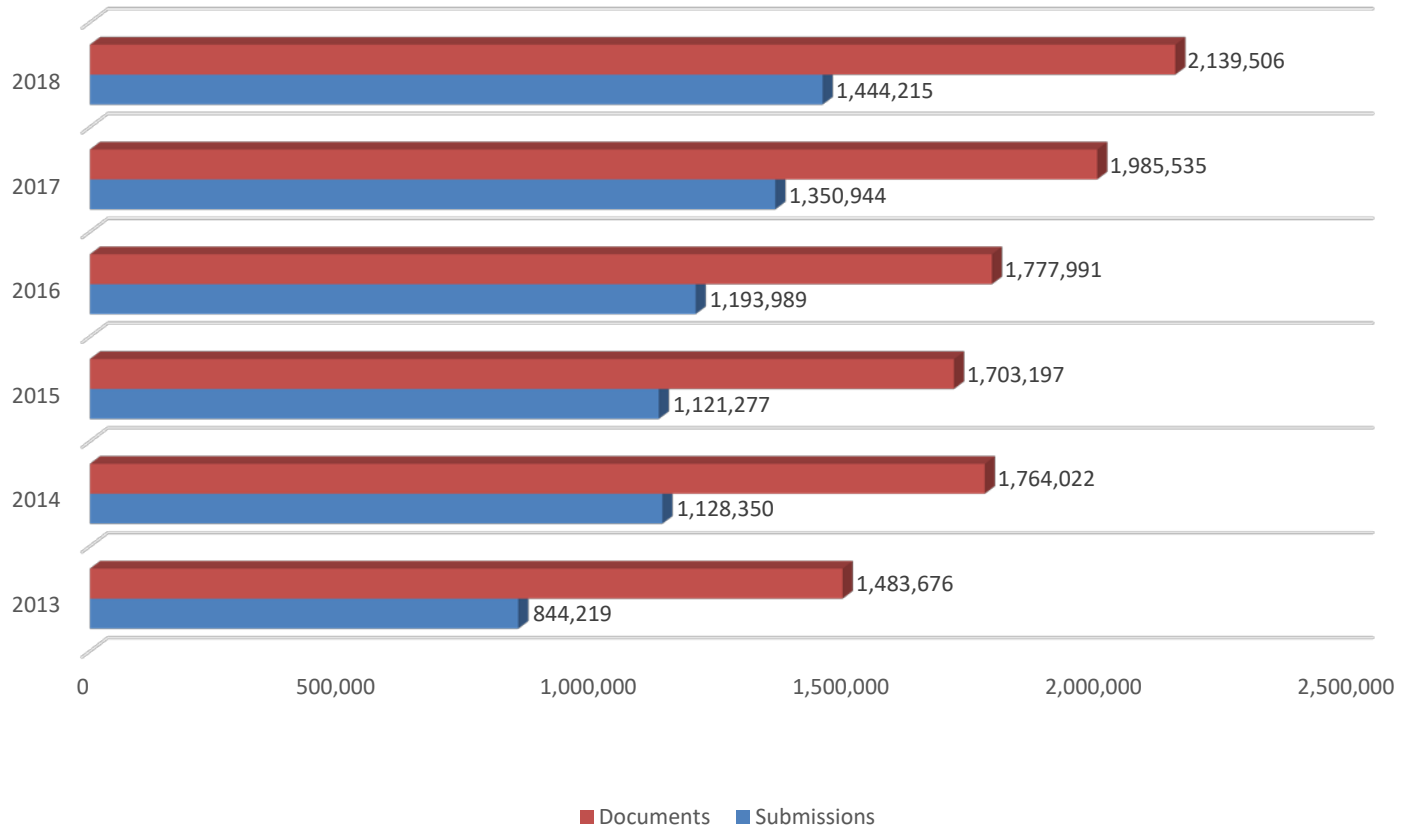


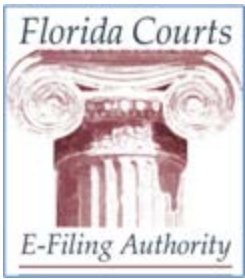
Year at a Glance



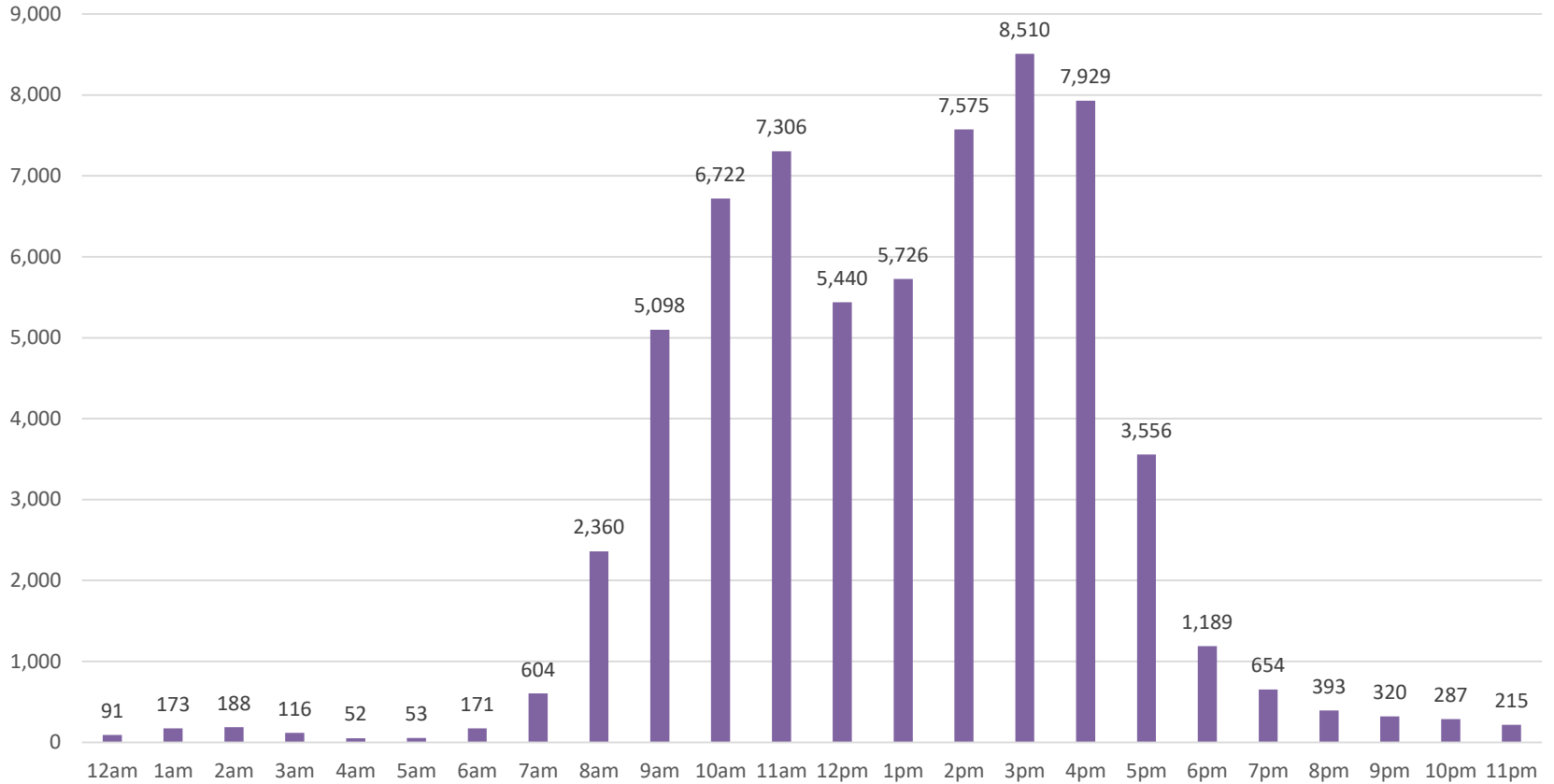


May E-Filing Last Six Years





May Average # Filings Per Hour



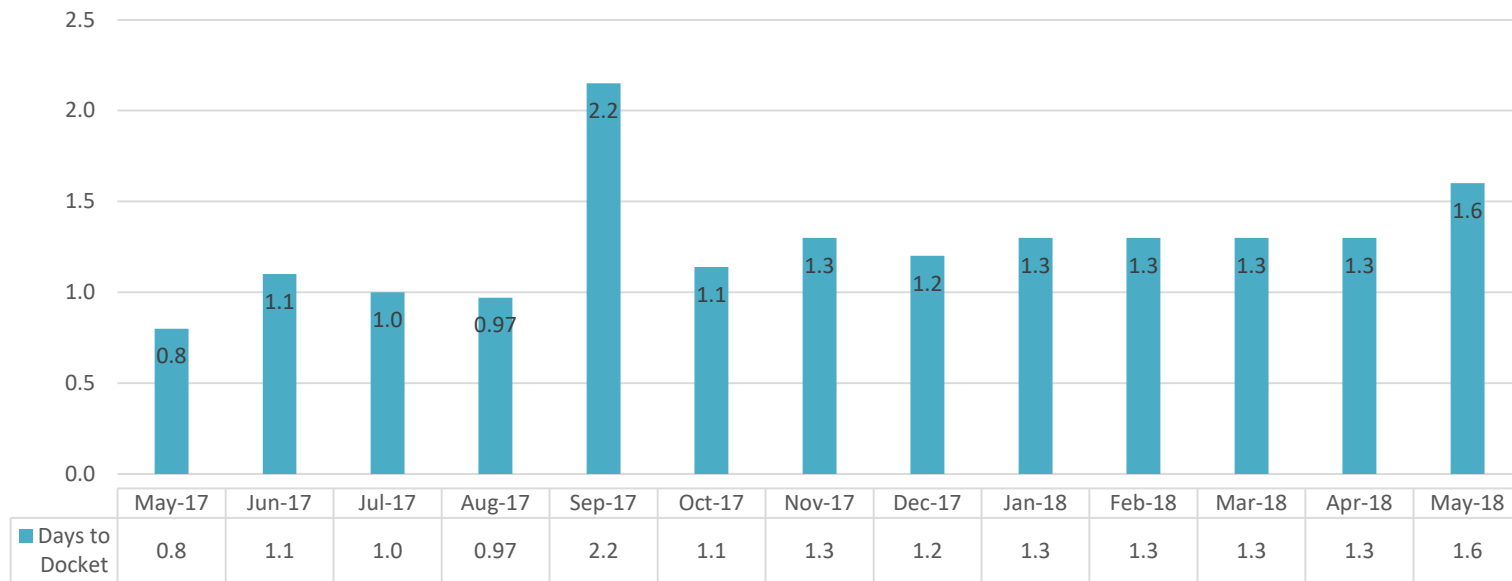

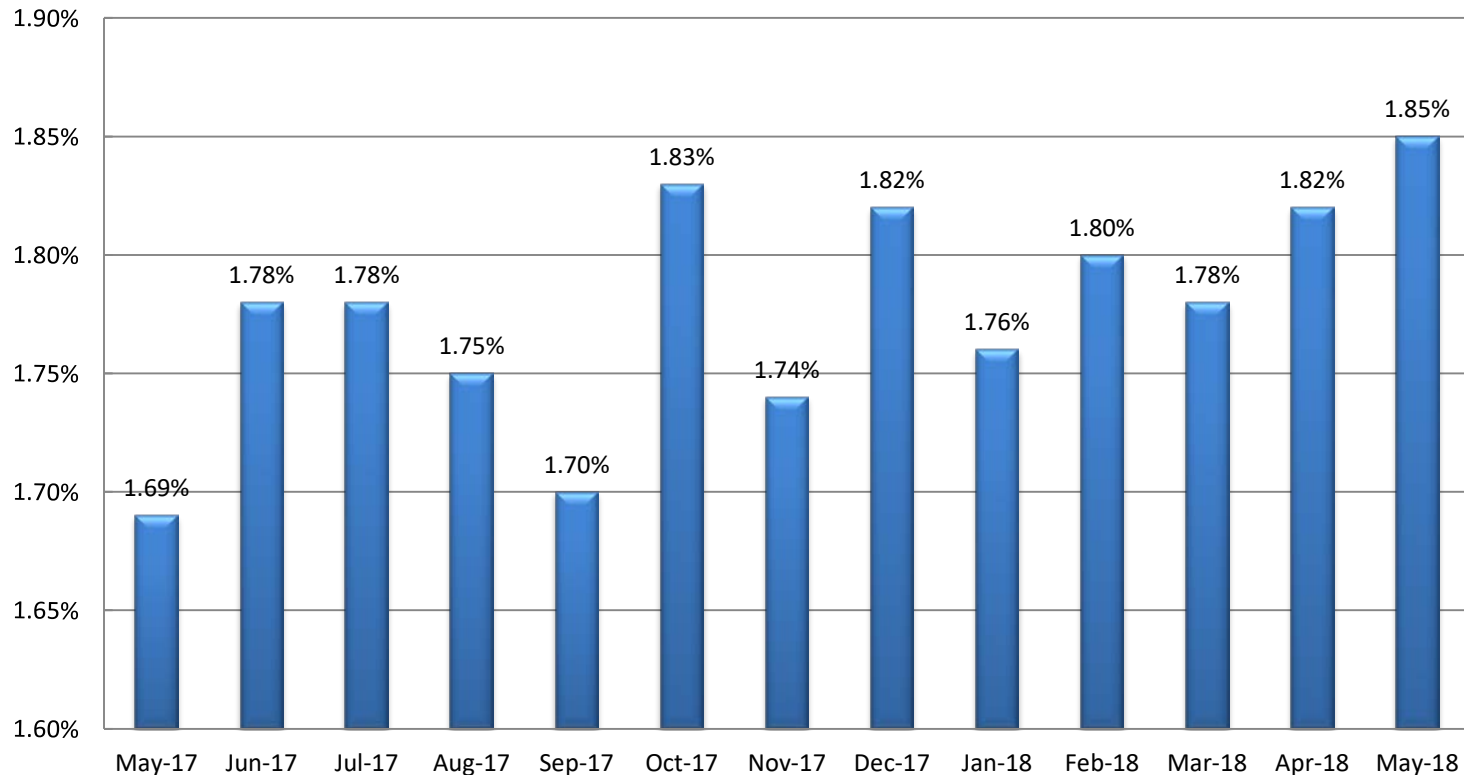
Average # Days to Docket in May

% Submissions Returned to Correction Queue in May



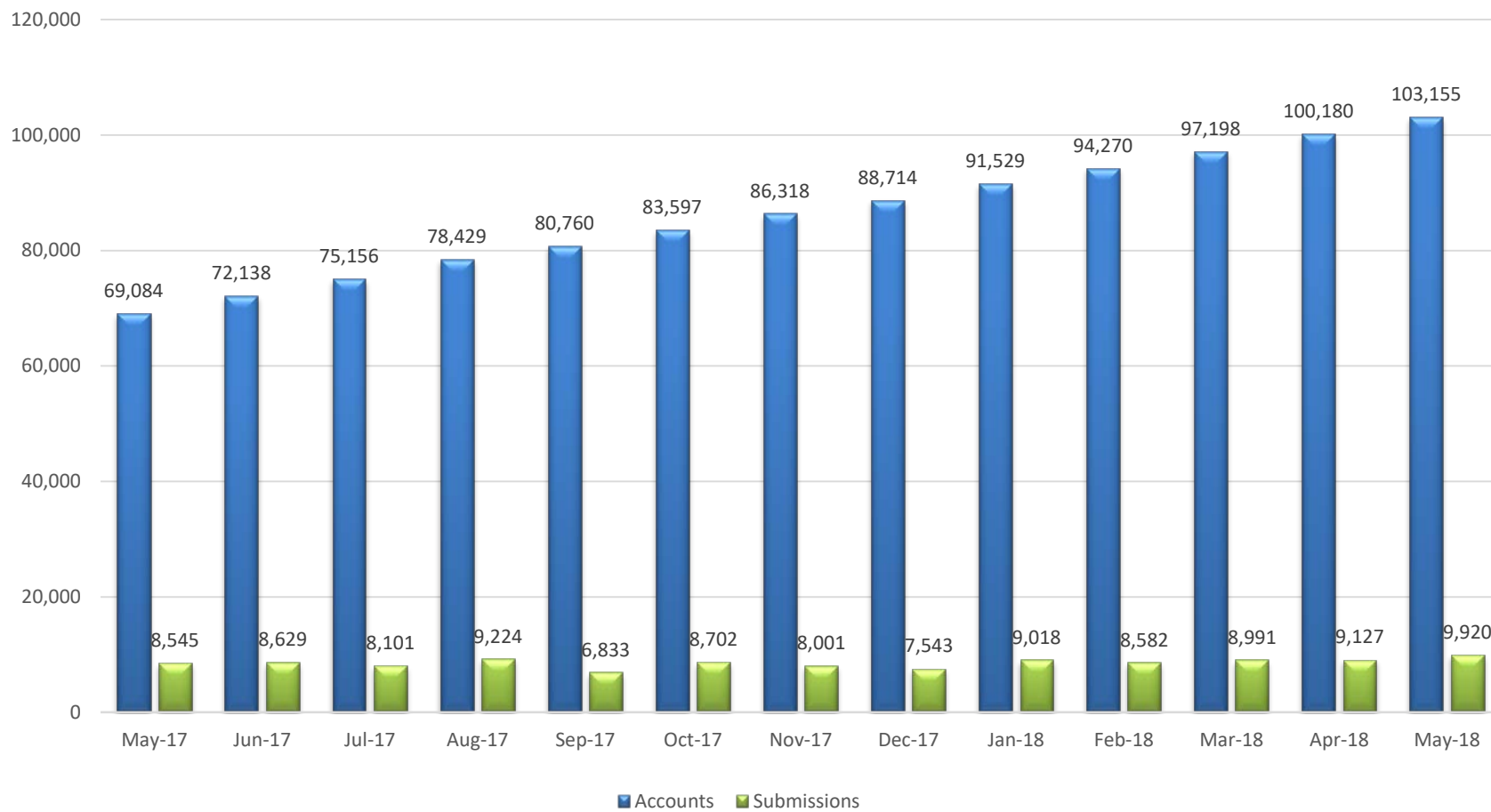


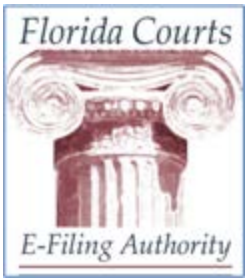

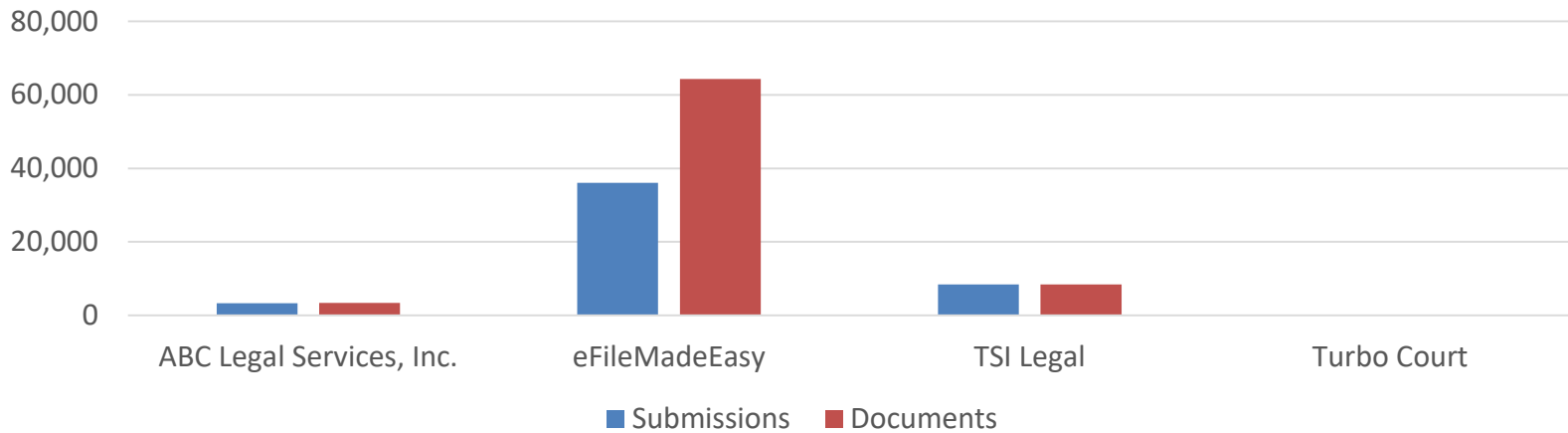
Self-Represented Litigant Accounts and Submissions

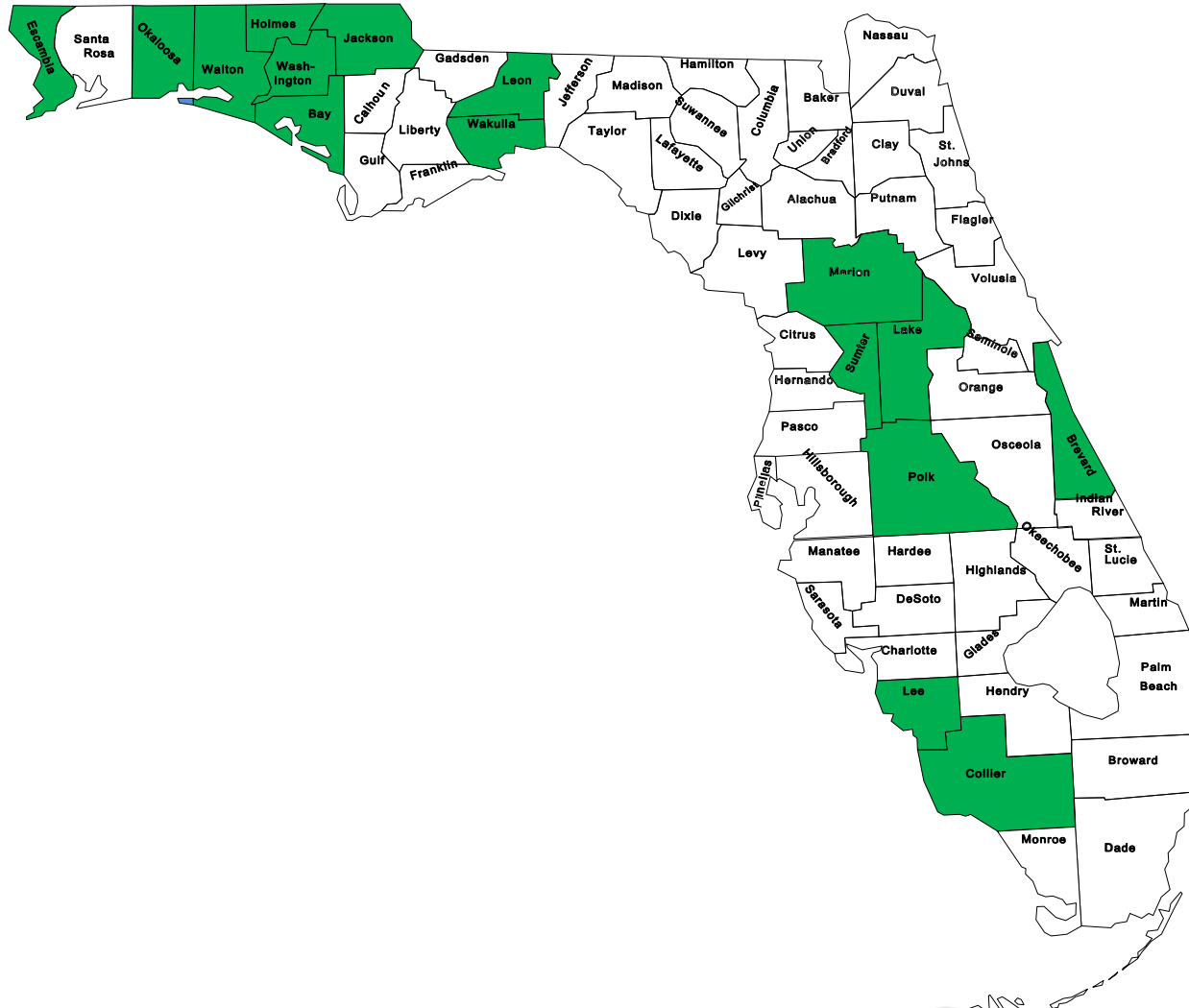
