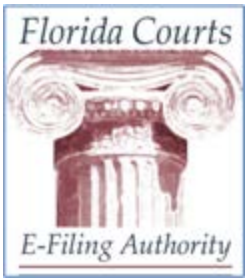

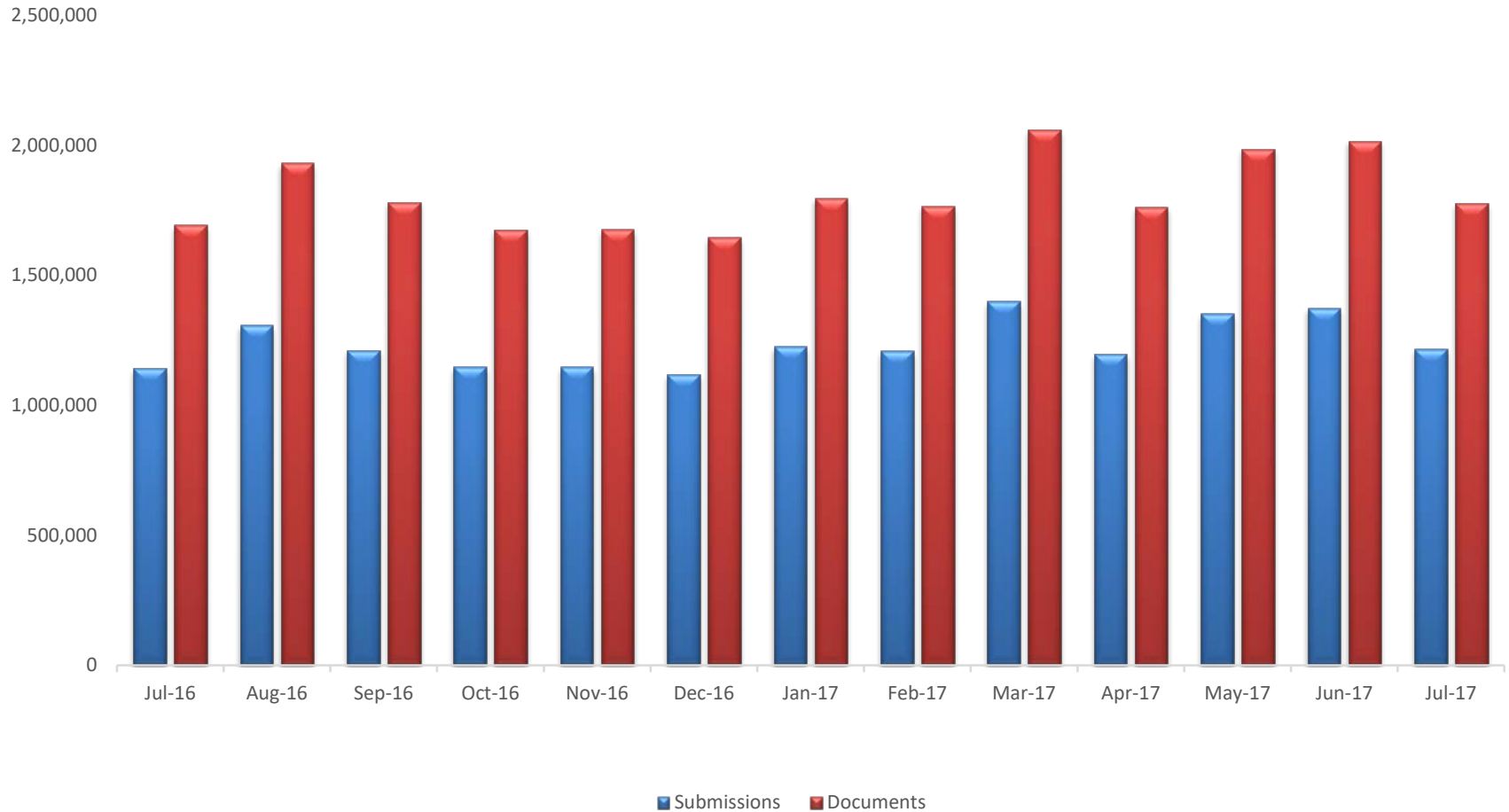

June had the most new cases filed during a given month at 71,980

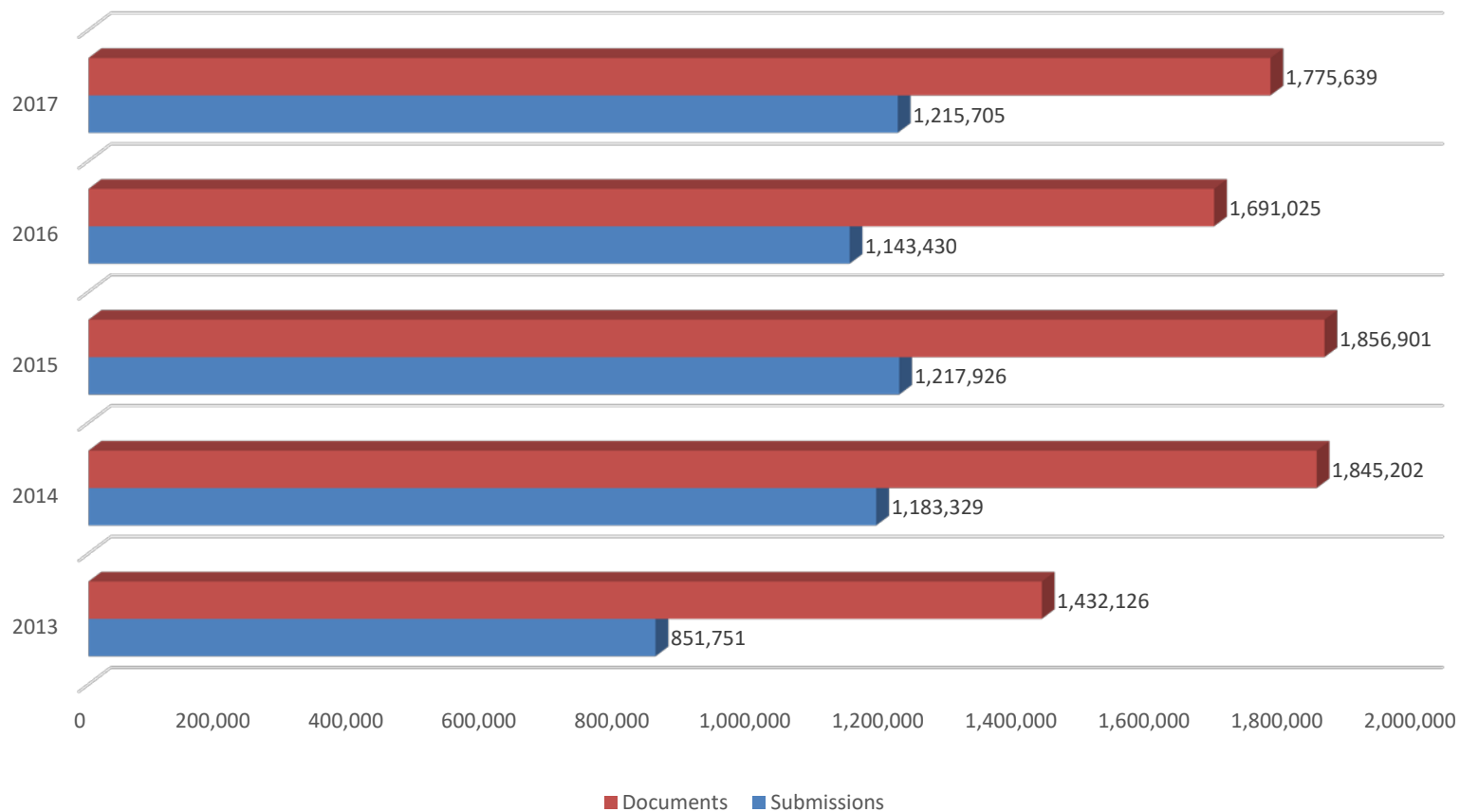


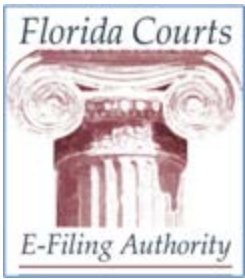
Year at a Glance



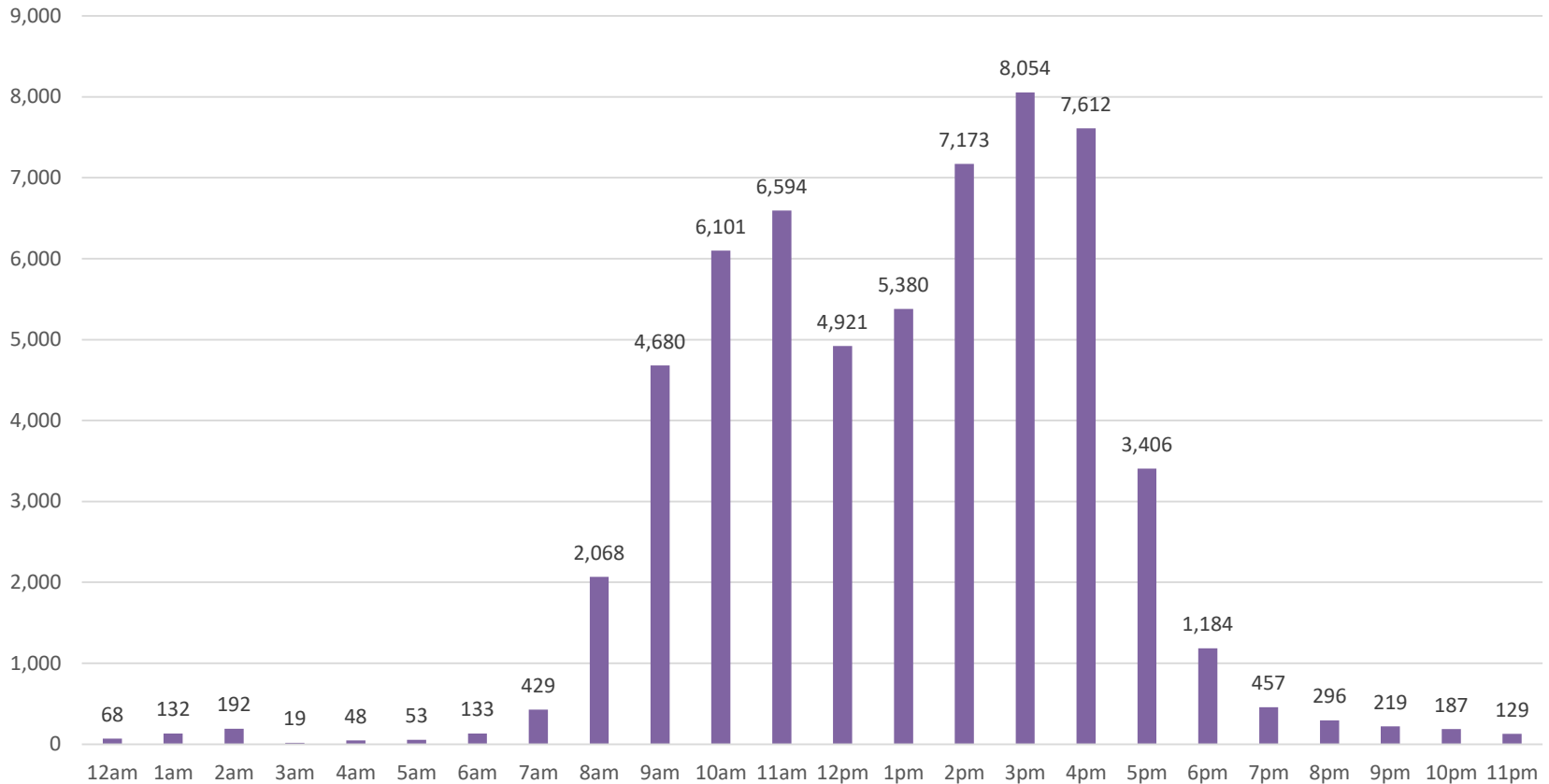


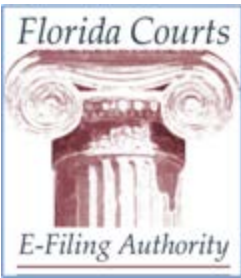
July E-Filing Past 5 Years



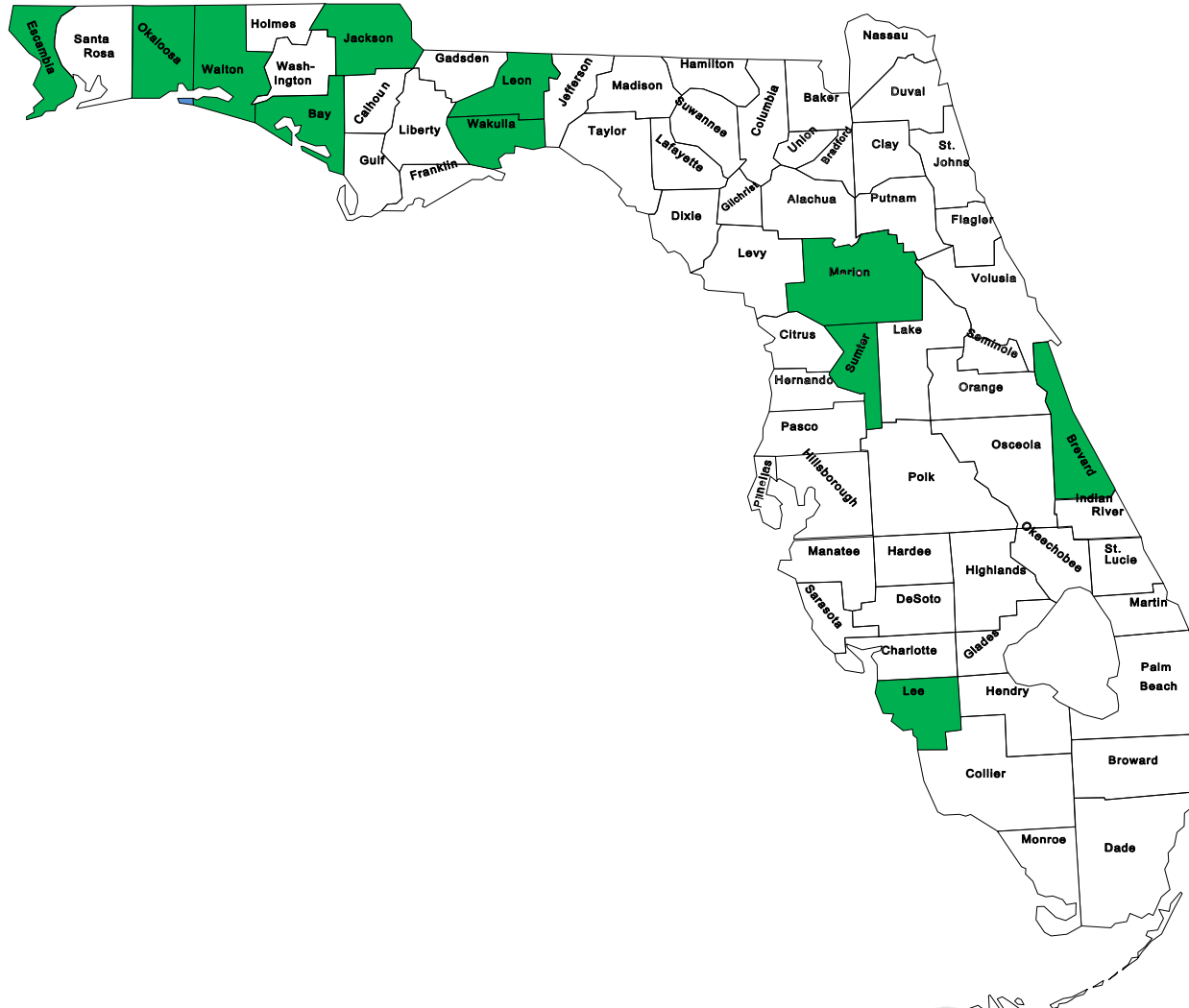


Average # Filings Per Hour





Accepting Proposed Orders via Portal



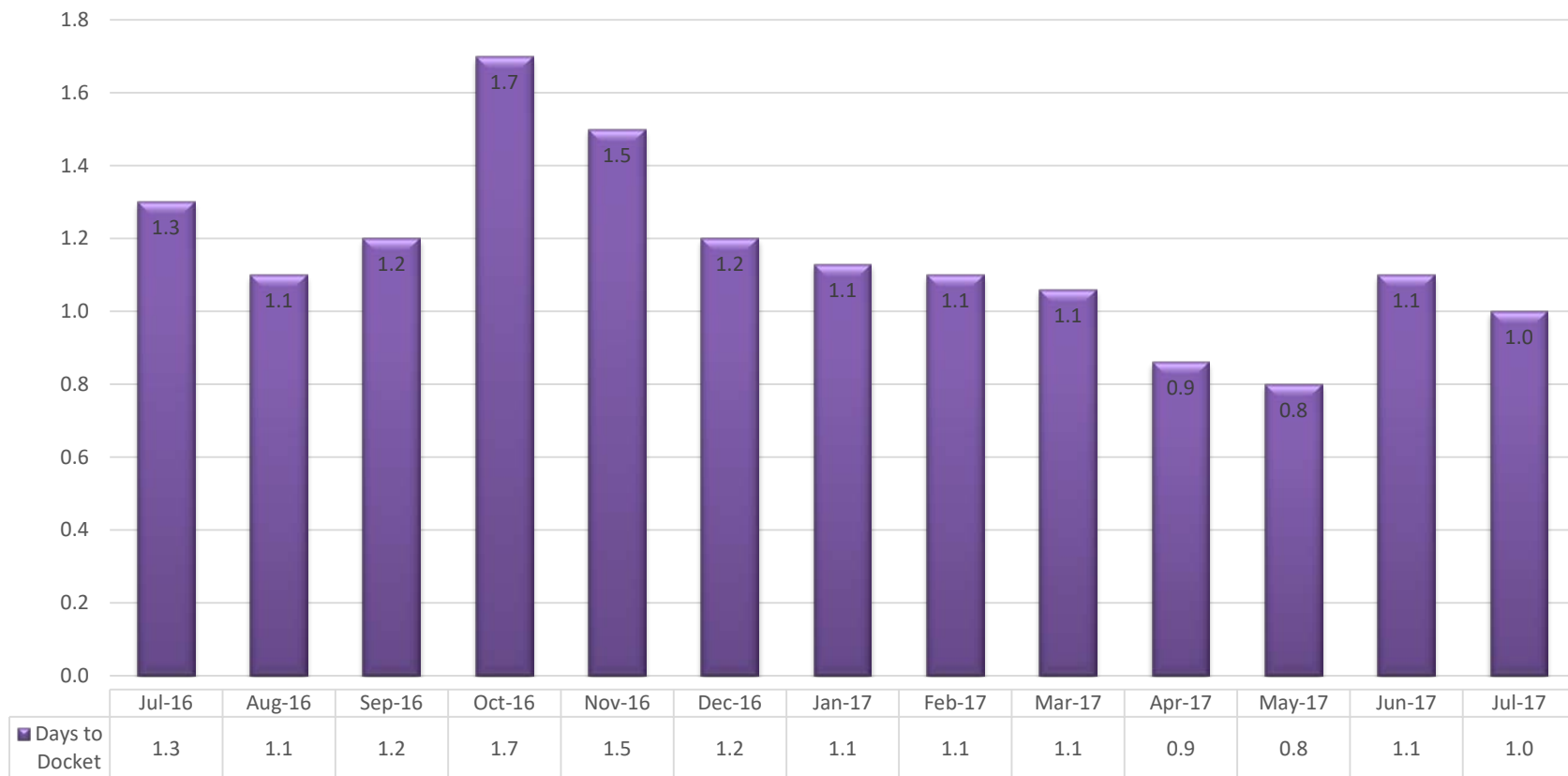

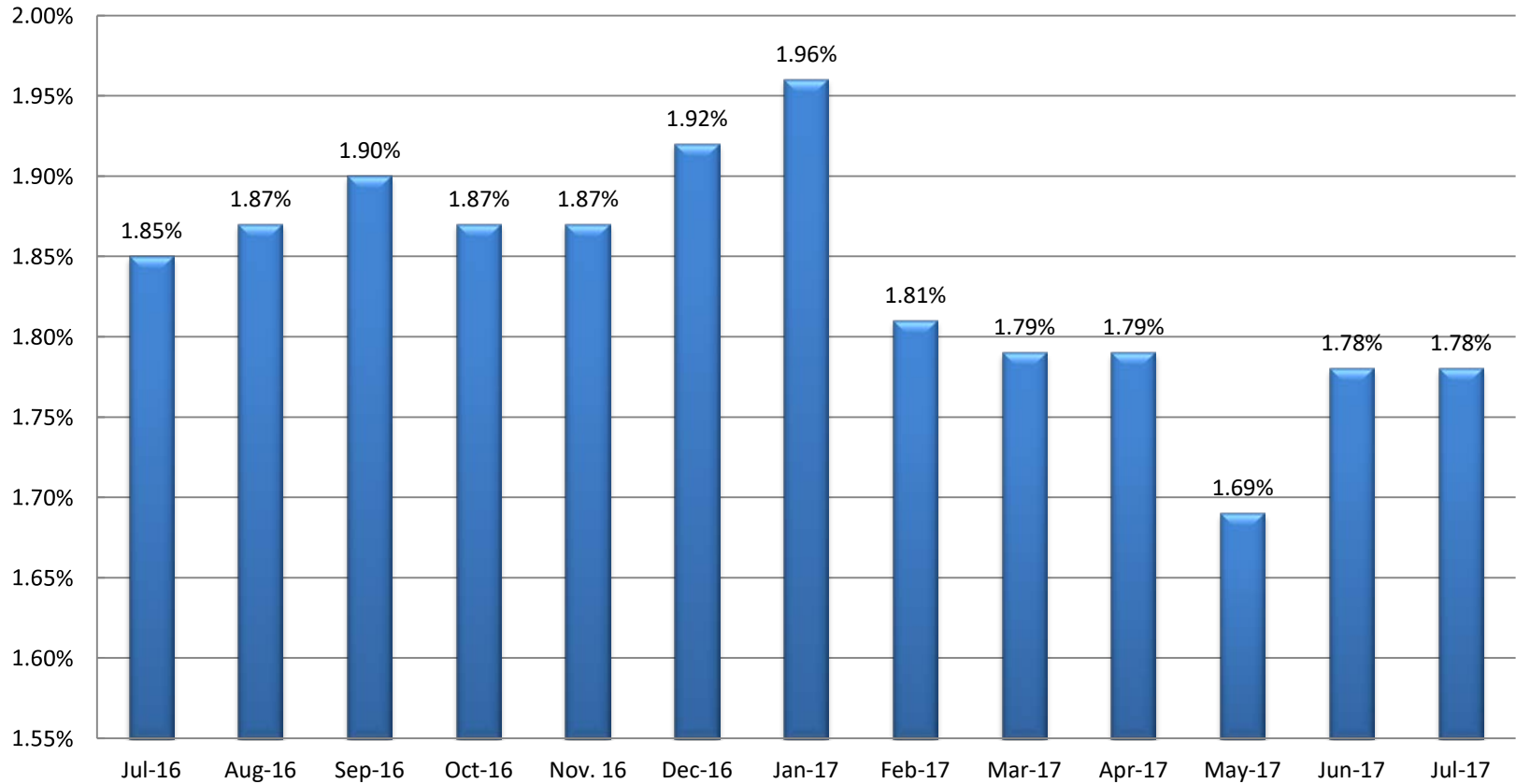


Average # Days to Docket
