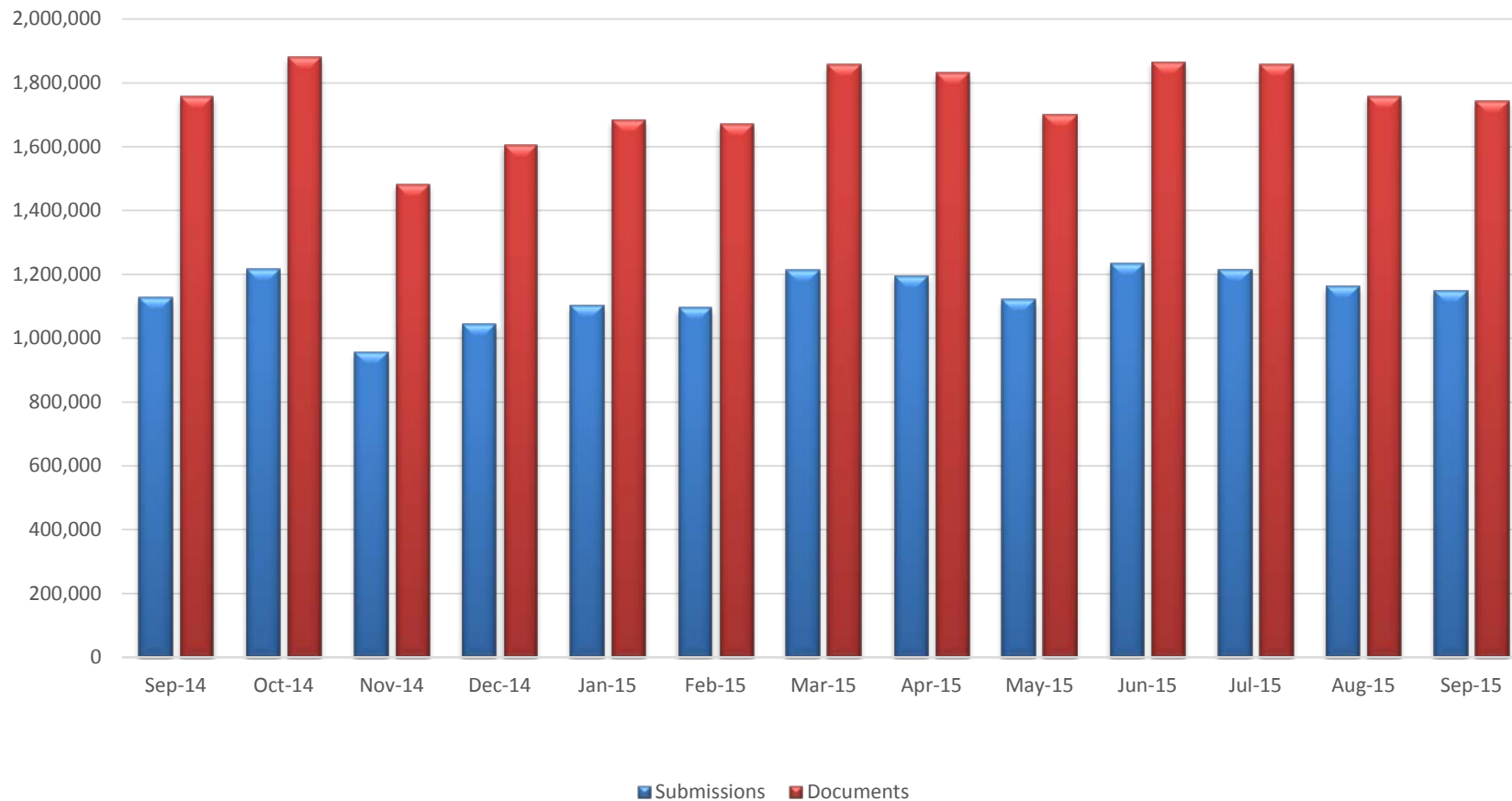


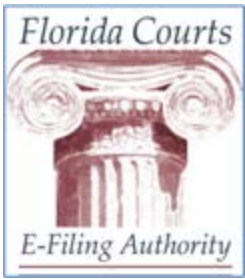

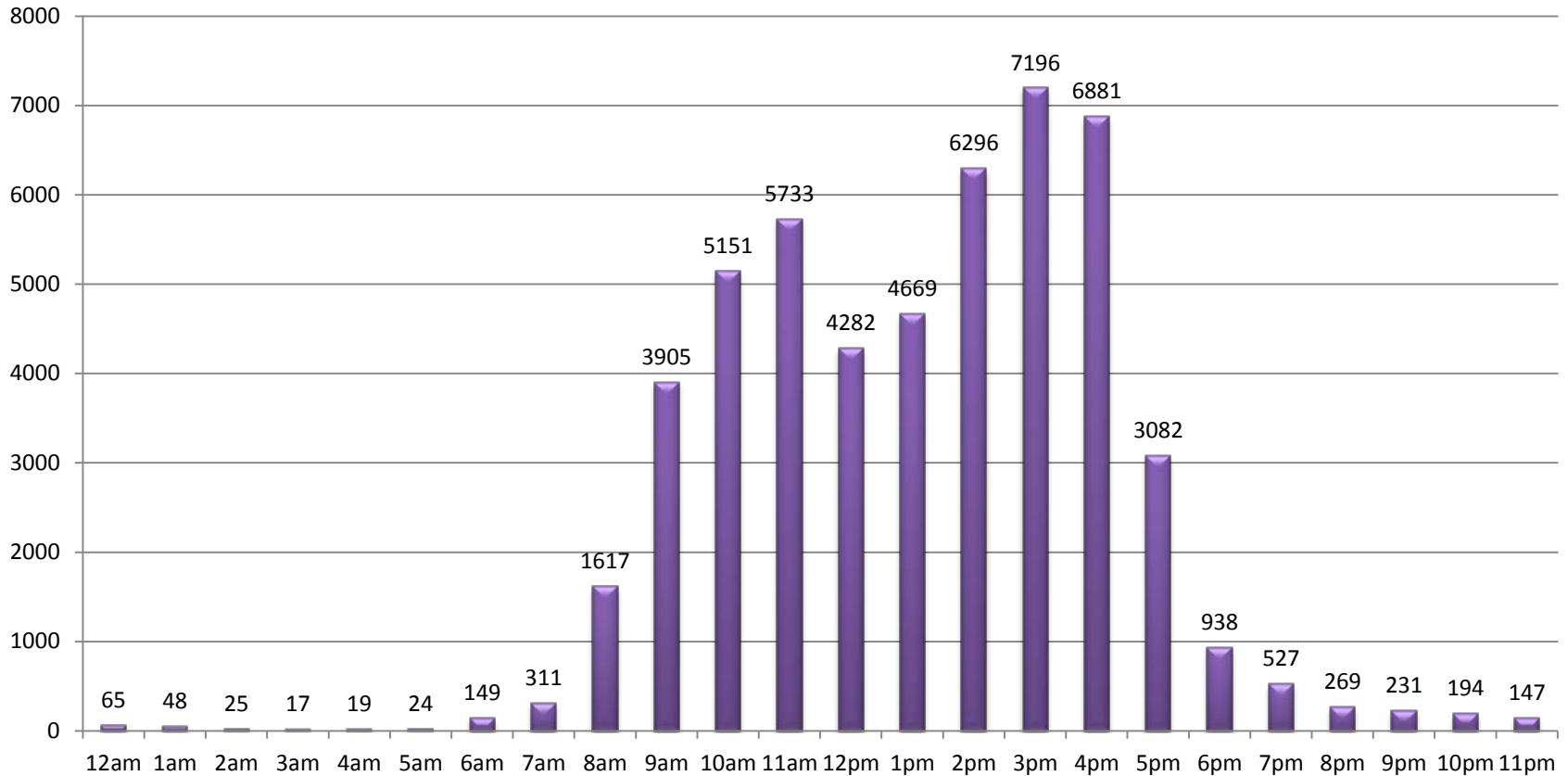


Monthly E-Filing Submissions for Sept. 2014 through Sept. 2015



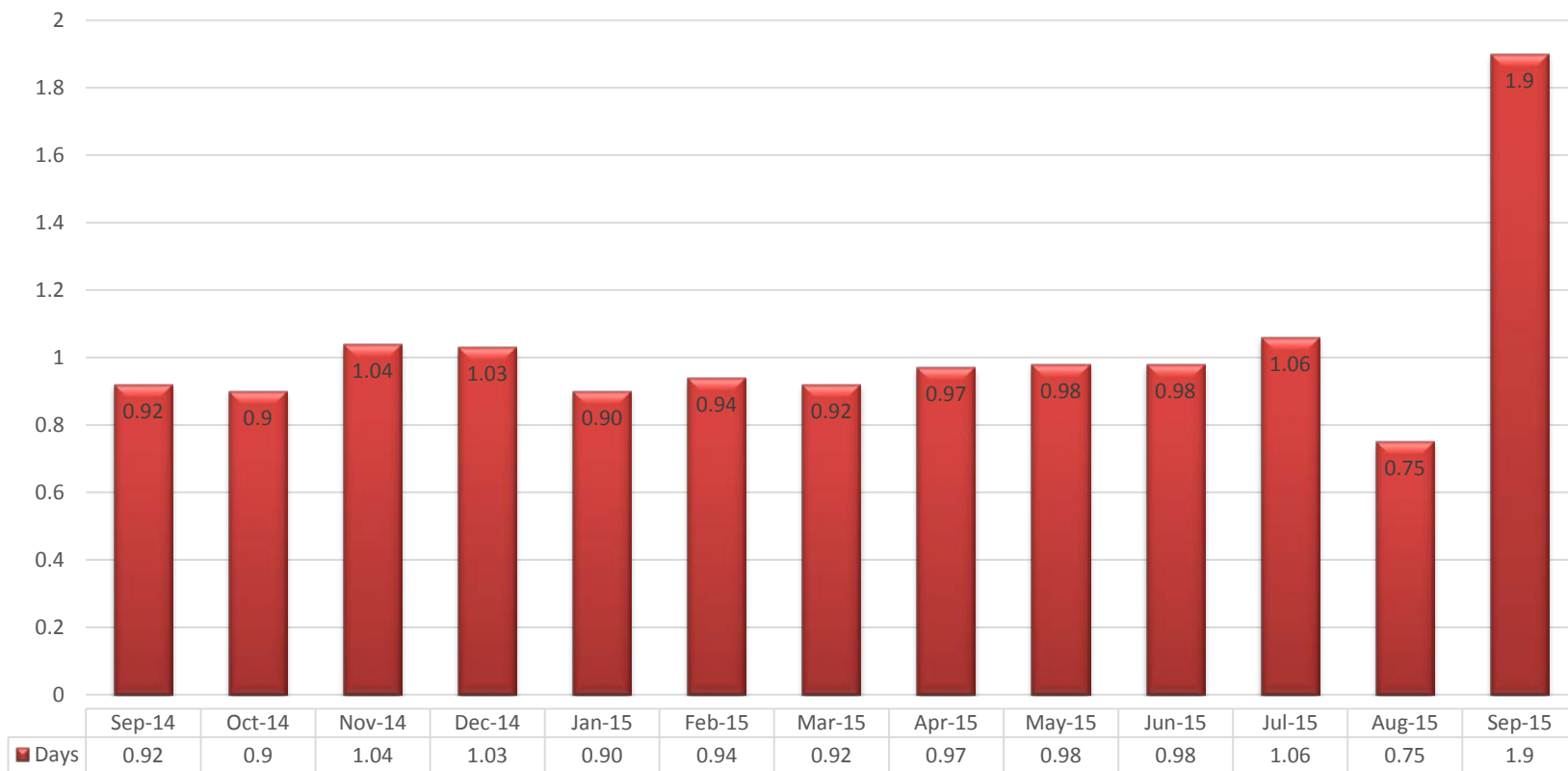


September Average Hourly Submissions



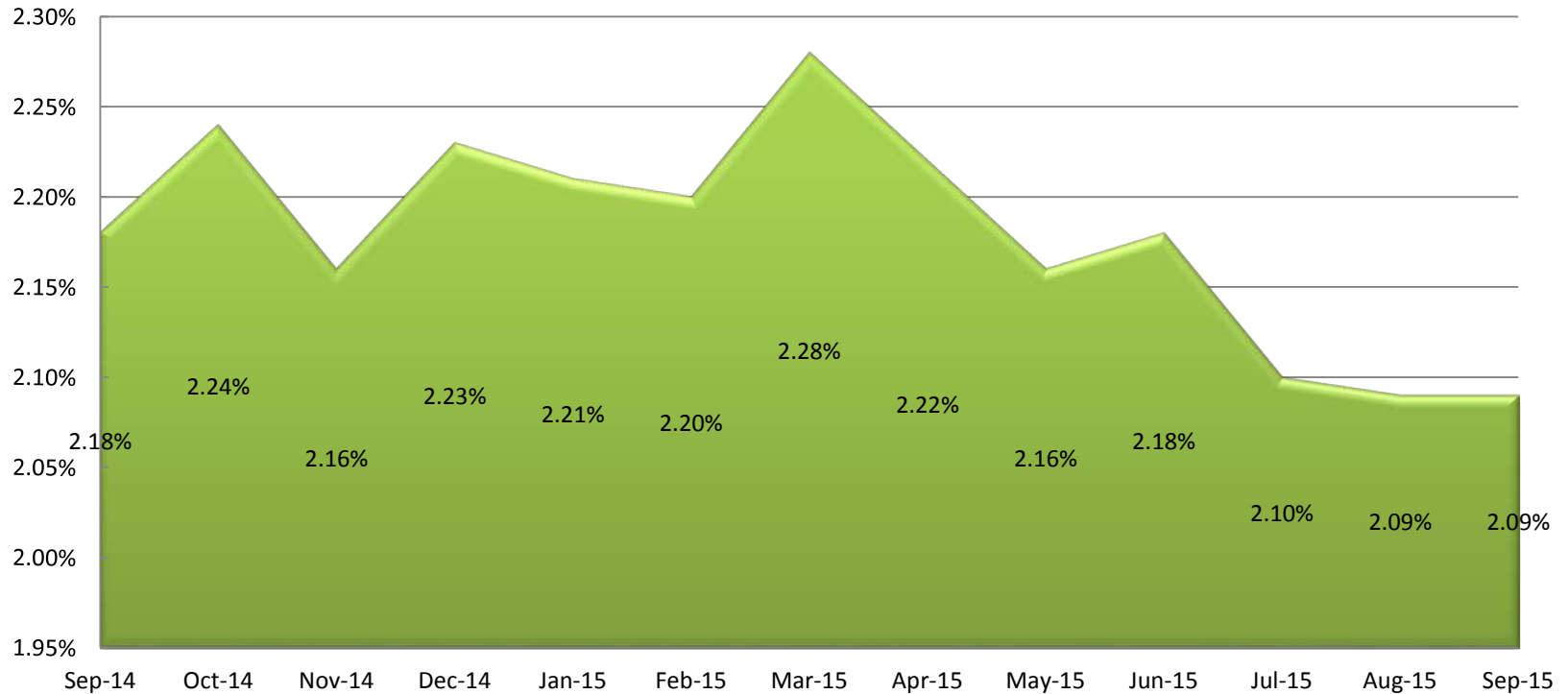


Average # Days to Docket for September

Texas, who also has a state-wide Portal, has a Pending Queue rate of 8%

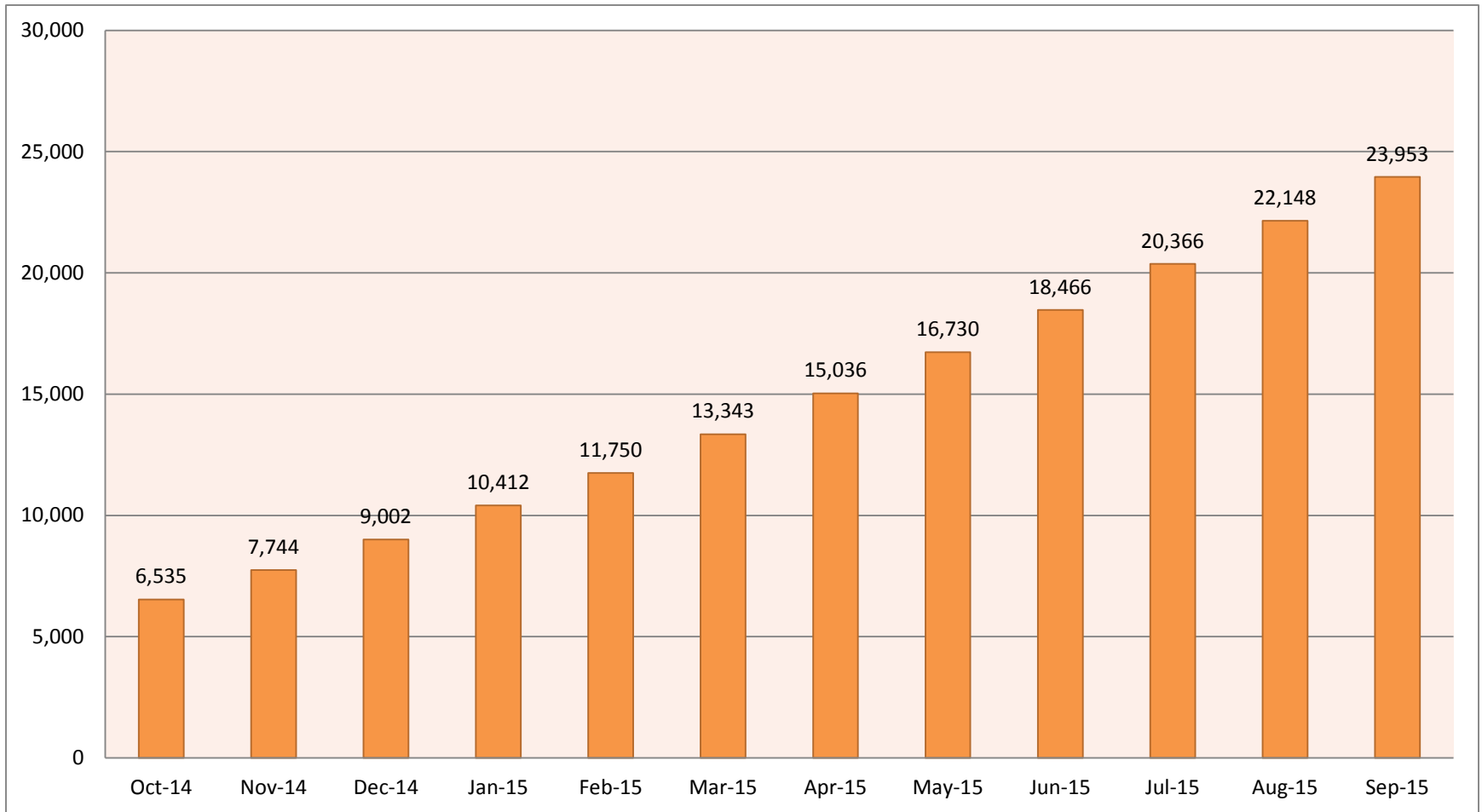
