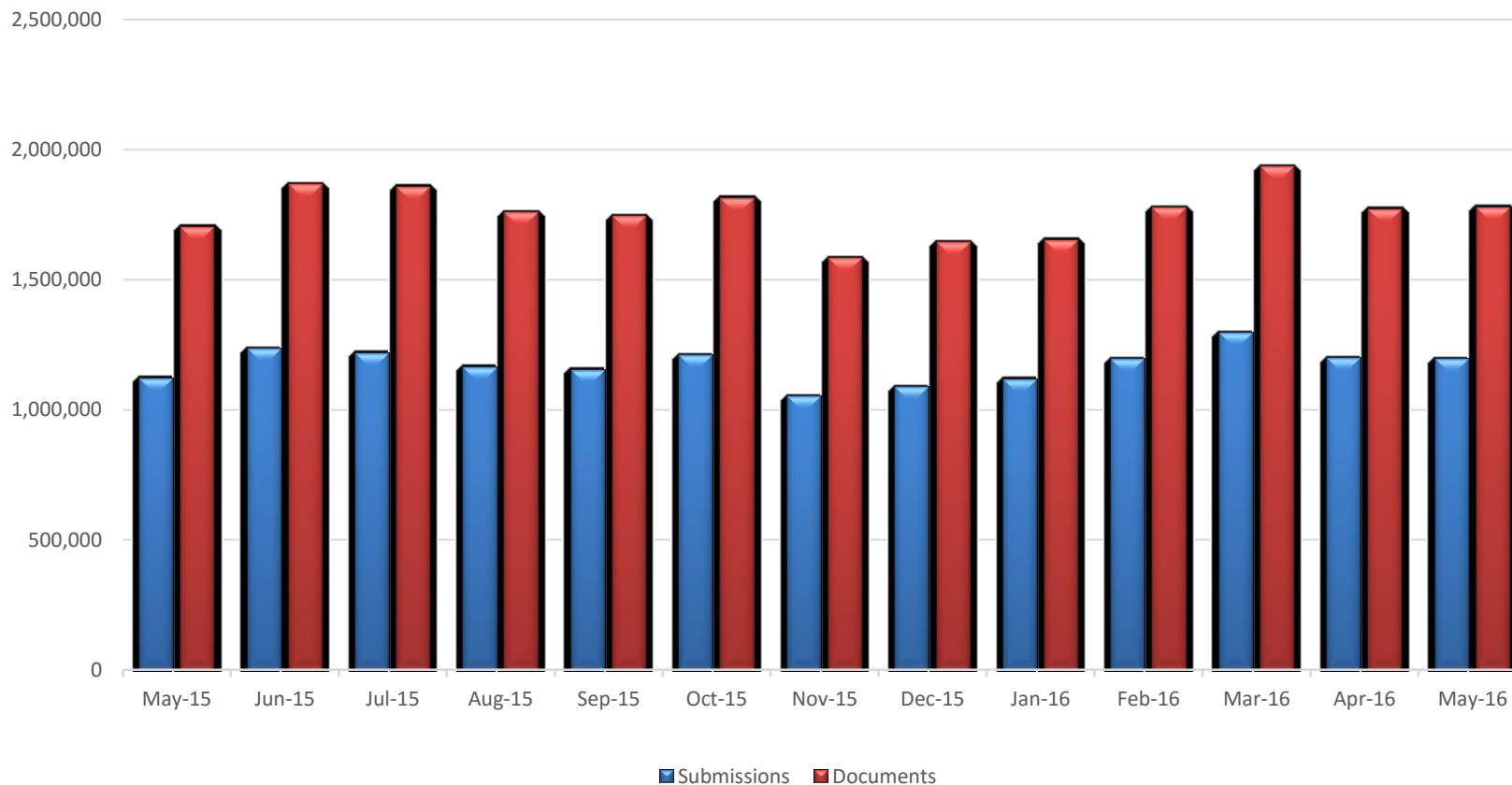

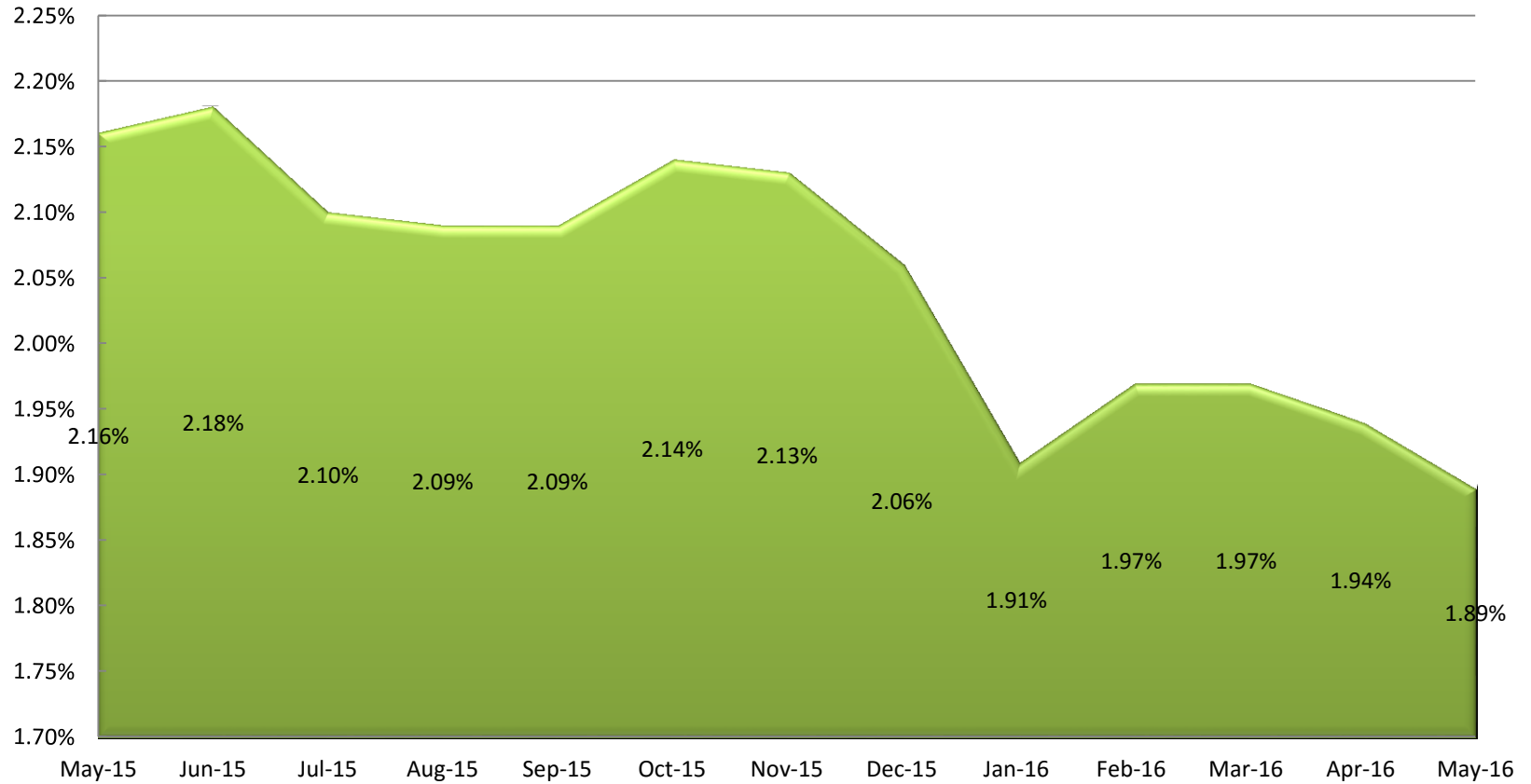


Monthly E-Filing Submissions for May 2015 through May 2016

 - Do not resubmit
 - Leave submission in pending queue until Clerk updates status to Abandoned Filing where the filer can no longer update that submission

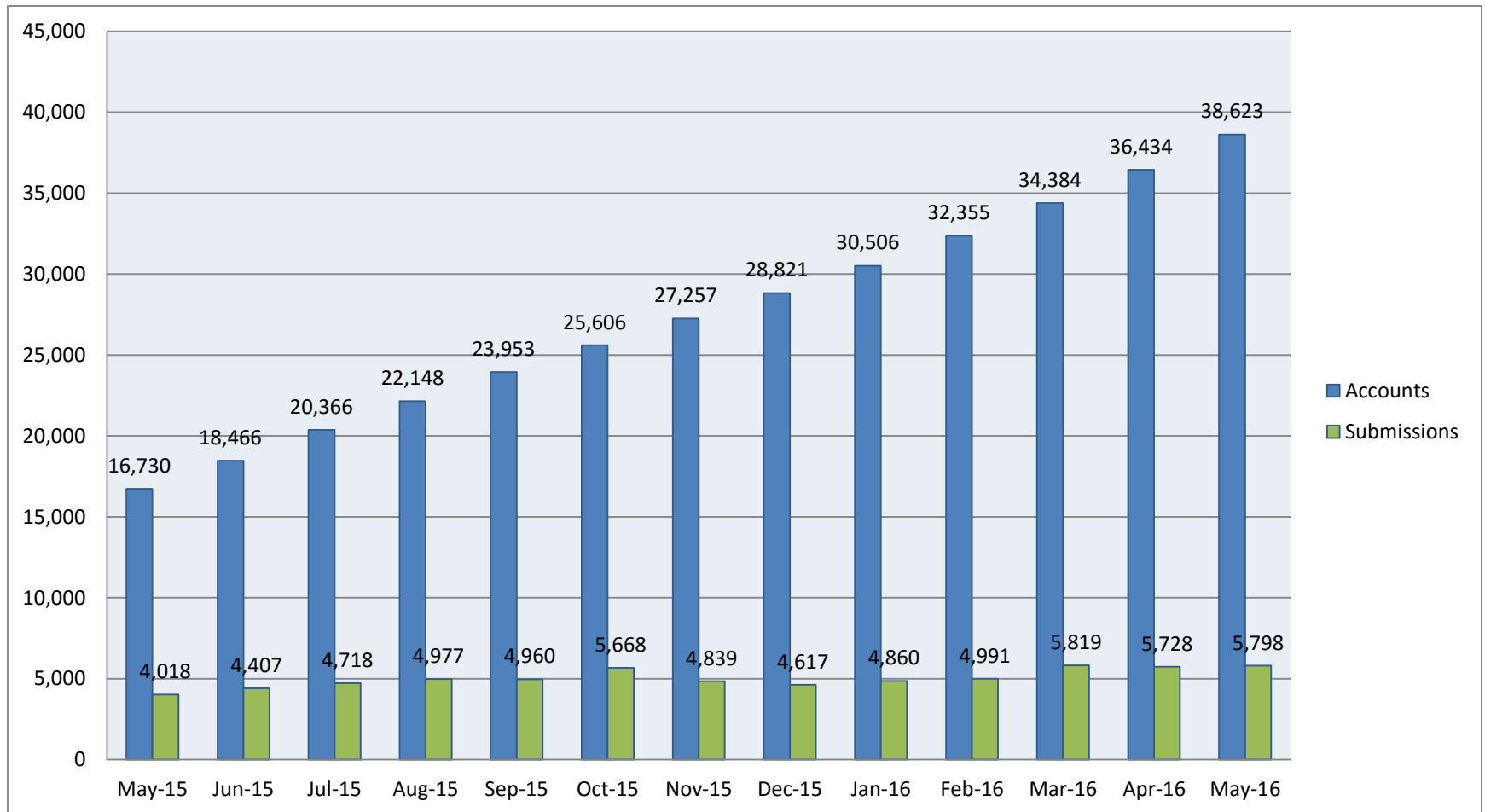
