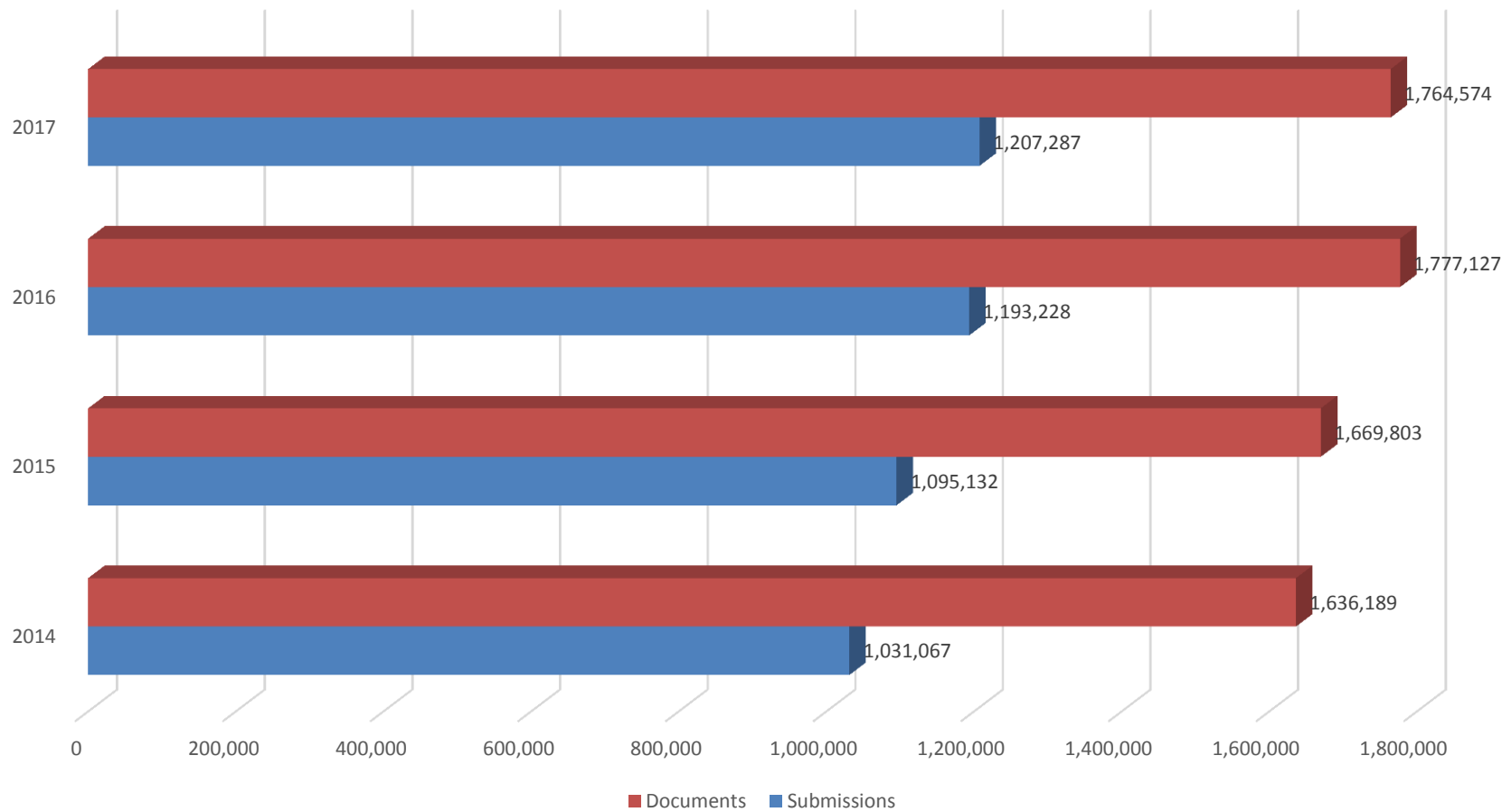


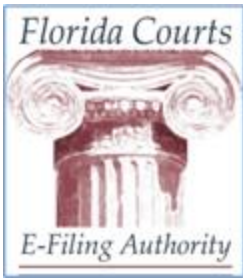

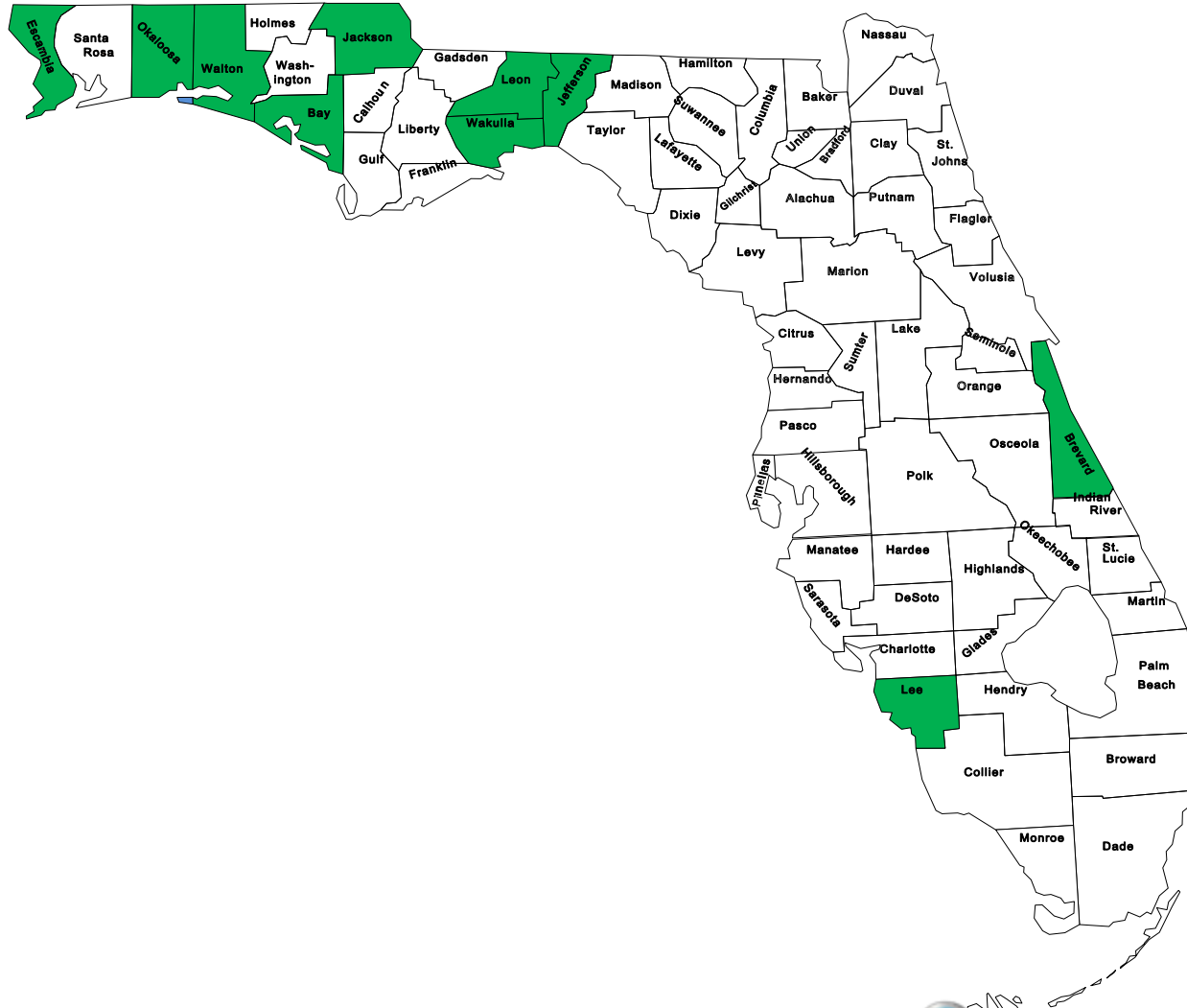


# February Activity Past 4 Years





# Accepting Proposed Orders via Portal



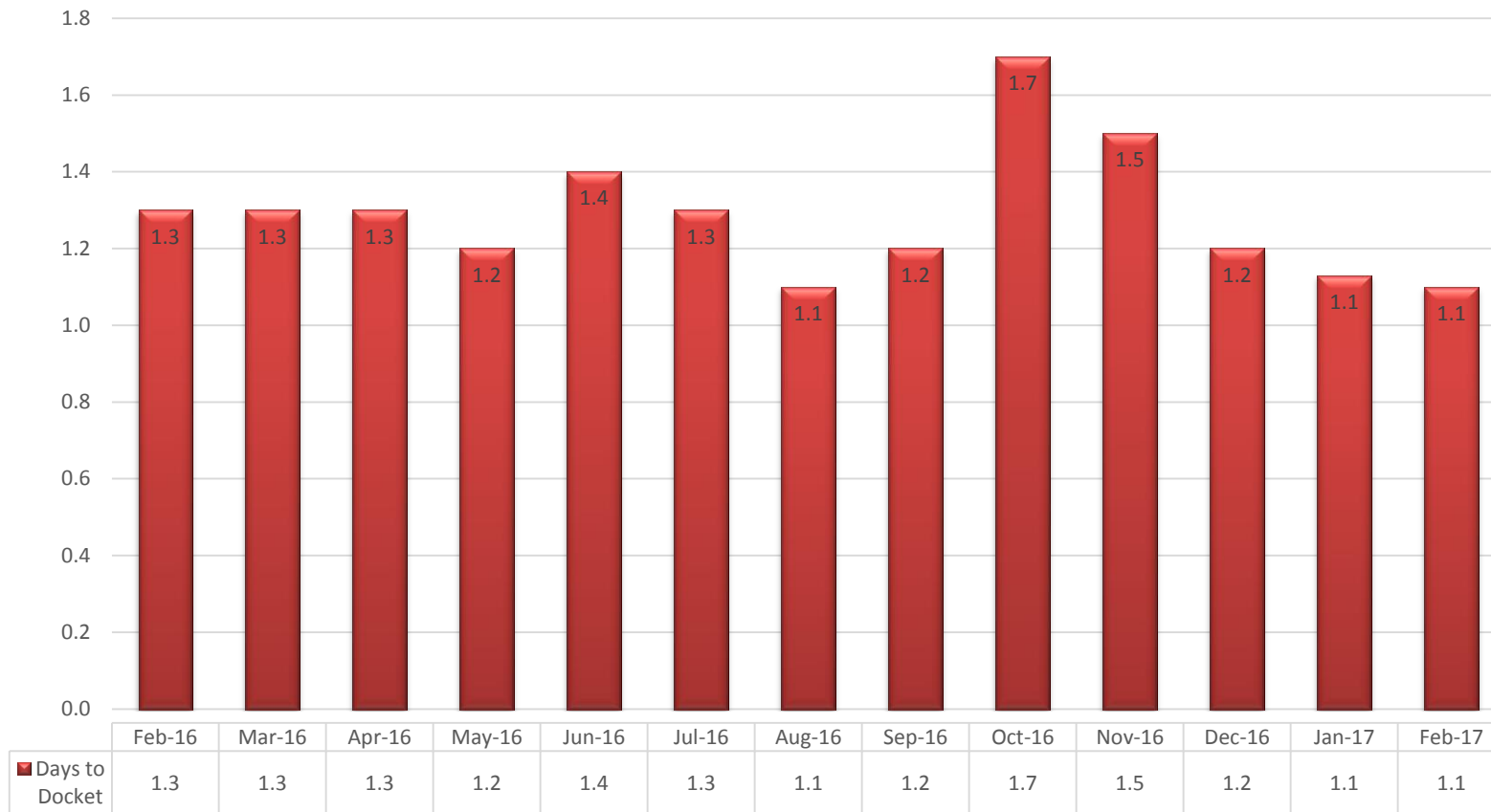


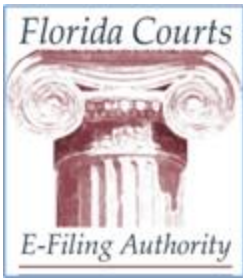

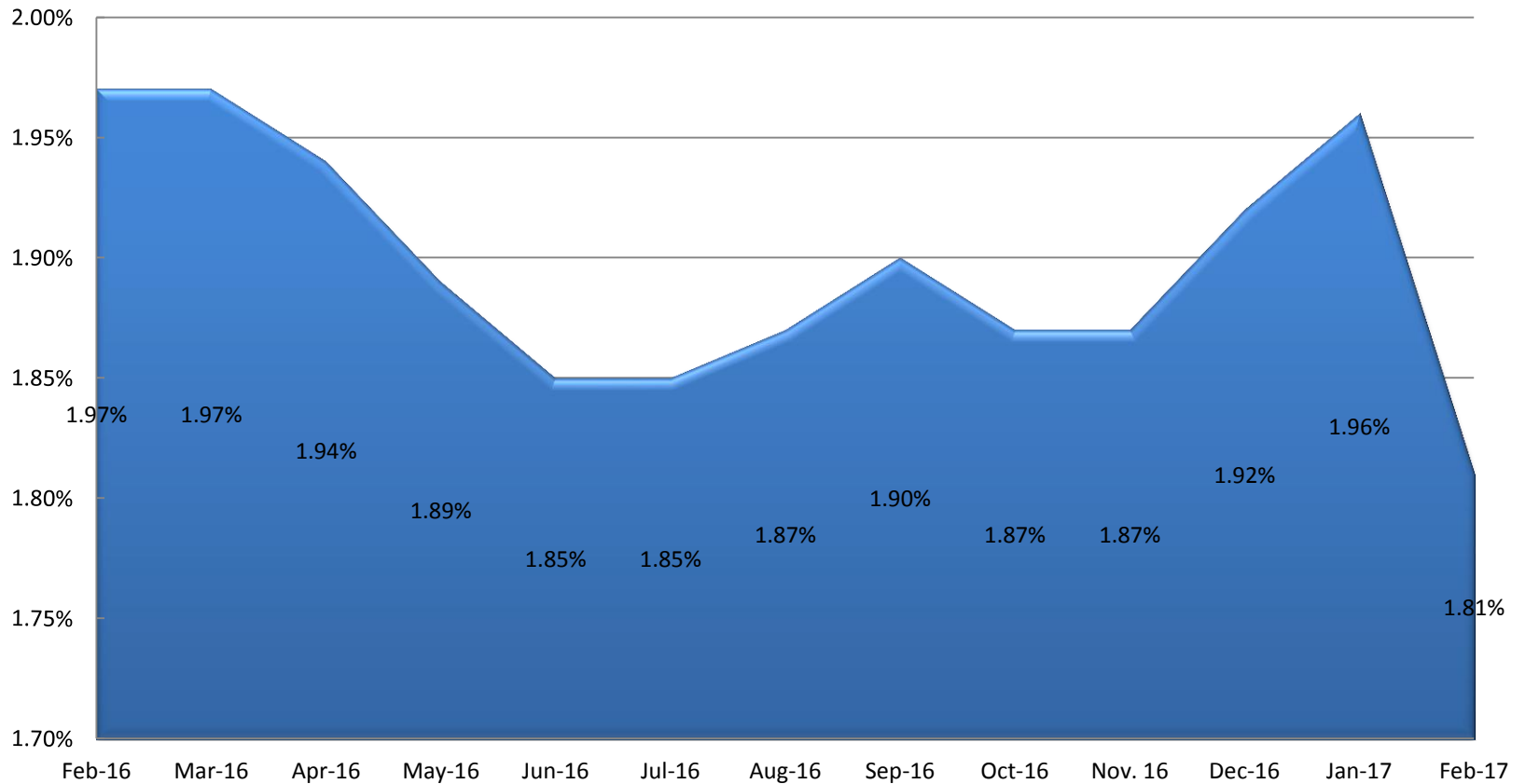


# Average # Days to Docket

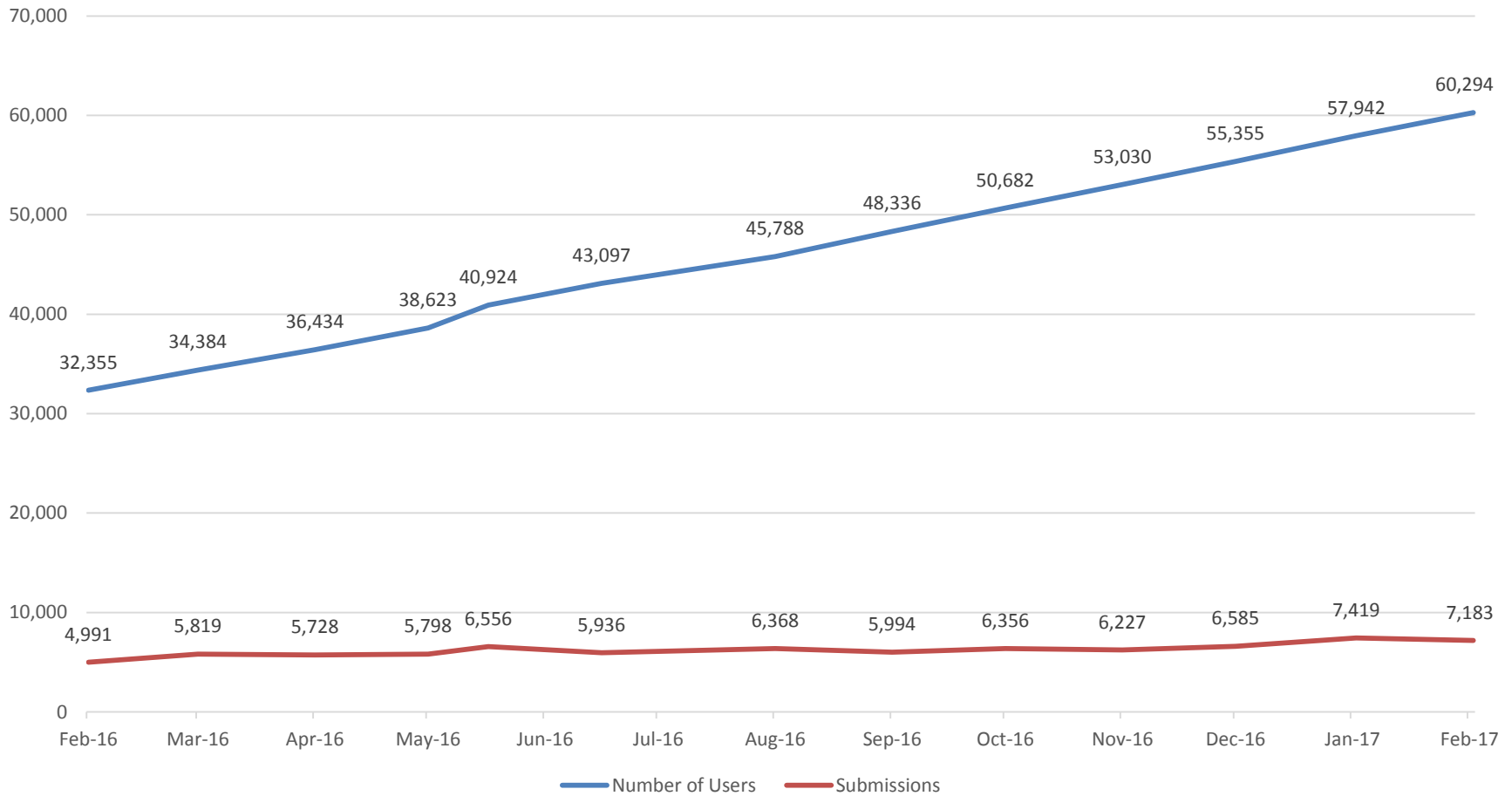
